

**Amendment 8040-I-032905**

-An amendment to the Bylaws changing the time at which amendments are adopted

Section XVII of the Bylaws shall be amended to read:

Section XVII.

- A. Any Senator may propose an amendment to these bylaws.
- B. A three-fifths (3/5) affirmative vote of the entire Senate shall be required for an amendment. Four-fifths (4/5) of the total Senate membership must be present for a vote of passage to be taken on an amendment.
- C. No amendment to these Bylaws shall be adopted unless and until it has had a first reading, a committee report, and a second reading, each at a separate meeting of the Senate.
- D. Amendments, once defeated, may not be considered for the remainder of the academic term.
- E. Amendments shall come into effect in the next Student Government term unless otherwise specified in the Amendment.**
