# Living room



This is the living room - directly inside front door. In the mirror you can see Dawn heading upstairs



## Stairs - From top

- The front door is just to the lower right of the plant.  
Living room to lower left.

# Kitchen from back of house

# Kitchen (looking left)



- The other side of "Dave's Daiquiri Nook." Pass through on left goes to the Living room, hallway on right goes to Dining Room. There is a breakfast nook with a bay window behind the camera man.

# Backyard



Grill is right outside back door (seen in living room pic.) Backyard is big with ONLY grass and eye-sores.

# Master bath



In the mirror, You can see the camera man, and the 2 steps down from the master. To the right of his legs in the mirror, you can see the two steps back up to the toilet... Cool vanity though.

# Master bath (looking right)



The whirlpool tub and shower... (you can see the two steps and toilet in mirror). Hopefully this is the last time ya'll see that wallpaper too!

# Master bedroom

# Study



When you go up the stairs, you pass the Master, then enter the study (Dave's bathroom is on the right). The window shown here faces the front.

# Dave's Bathroom
