- STARTING TIME:** Of camp will be between 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. on the first day of camp. Please do not drop campers off any earlier and if possible not later as camp will have started.
- CLOSING TIME:** Of camp will be between 10:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. on the last day of camp. Please do not be late as the staff needs to close up the camp and prepare for the next group.
- WHAT TO BRING:** Bedding (Warm Blankets or Sleeping Bags, Pillow) For a single bed. Towels, Washcloth, Toothbrush and Toothpaste. Warm pajamas, Bathing Suit. Suitable Clothing for Warm, Cool, or Wet Weather. Bible, Notebook, Pencil, Mosquito Lotion, Sun Screen, Water Bottle (for drinking) with campers name on it.
- OPTIONAL:** Flashlight, Camera, Sports Equipment. A Second Towel for the Beach is often a good idea.
- DO NOT BRING:** Any Shoes that do not cover the Foot (Thongs, Sandals). Jewelry, Money, Walkmans or Musical Equipment.
- MEDICATIONS:** Any medications or Pills must be given to the Nurse with written instructions. This includes aspirin or Tylenol.
- MEDICAL FORM:** **This year, our medical form was included with registration. To insure we have all current information, all Campers must report to the medical staff prior to parents leaving camp.**
- REMEMBER:** Please put the Camper's Name on Clothing and Belongings.
- NOTE:** No Smoking by Campers. Campers not following camp rules can expect to be sent home. Campers will be held responsible for malicious damage.
- DONATIONS:** Of Fresh Fruit and/or Vegetables would be Welcome.
- VOLUNTEERS:** Camp Tapawingo has a number of Full-time Staff, But the Camp would not be able to run without the added support of volunteers who are willing to give a week of their time to be a counselor or a nurse for one camp.
