- Applicants must submit duly completed and signed Entry Forms ("Entry Forms"). Entry Forms with incomplete and/or incorrect information may be rejected.
- The acceptance of entries is subject to full payment of the Entry Fees stipulated in the Entry Forms ("Entry Fees").
- Entry Forms may be submitted to the Organiser by post at **56 Koon Seng Road Singapore 426990 ATTN: My Fancy Goldfish Competition 2006**. Entry Forms must reach the Organiser by 3 May 2006 ("Closing Date"). Entry forms received by the Organiser after the Closing Date will NOT be entertained.
- The acceptance of entries will be subject to availability of space. Applicants will be advised of their entry status within 2 (two) weeks of the Closing Date.
- The Organiser reserves its right to reject any application and/or entry and/or cancel any class in its sole and complete discretion. The Organiser reserves its right not to provide any explanation for any such rejection and/or cancellation.
- The entry of a fish into an incorrect class and/or category by a participant may result in disqualification. Participants unsure about the classification and/or categorization of their entries are advised to contact the Organiser, *Vermillion Goldfish Club (SG)* email: greenngoldsg@yahoo.com for clarification, with an accompanying photograph of the fish, before submitting their entry forms.
- Entry Fees paid on confirmed entries are non-refundable notwithstanding subsequent withdrawal by the participant and/or disqualification of the entry through the participant's own default.
- Fish that have been benched in for competition may not be removed from their display tanks without the Organiser's prior written consent, until the stipulated benching-out time on the last day of the show.
- The judges' decisions are final and no complaints or disputes will be entertained.
- Whilst the Organiser will take best efforts to ensure the health and well-being of all participating fish for the duration of the competition, it shall not be held liable to any person for any loss, mortality, injury, sickness and/or any form of harm whatsoever to participating fish.
