1. PETER-1 BITHER, according to his pension record, was born about 1753 in Portsmouth, Hampshire, England, and died in Freedom, Maine, 4 March 1827. He married at Cape Elizabeth, Maine, 4 Feb. 1777, HUNICE STROUT, "both of Cape Elizabeth" (manuscript record of marriages performed by Rev. Ephraim Clark, in possession of the Maine Historical Society, Portland). Her parentage has not yet been determined.

Tradition says that Peter, when a small boy some four or five years of age, was taken aboard a British man-of-war at Portsmouth and brought to this country, where the ship's Captain left him with some Boston friends who took pity on the small waif.

In early days the British government found it difficult to get enough sailors ~~to man their ships~~ to man their ships, and to offset this difficulty offered their freedom to such prisoners as would volunteer to join the crews of ships bound for Australia, America or any far away port, and not return to England for a long period of years. Consequently sailors were usually ignorant, cruel, cunning and even dangerous. They teased little Peter unmercifully during the long trip across the Atlantic. His only means of defense was to bite them, so they dubbed him "Peter Biter," a name by which he was known for years until the family which befriended him changed the spelling to Bither.

The ship's Captain told his Boston friends that just before the man-of-war left the British harbor, and during the absence of the Captain himself on shore, the officer in charge had been approached by a man whom he judged was of the titled or wealthy class, who merely told him the child was to be delivered to friends in America and not brought back. Supposing the Captain knew all about it, the subordinate officer accepted the responsibility. The Captain returned to his post, the ship sailed, and in due time the child was brought to the attention of the Captain, who was much mystified.

The trials of the little boy on the trip can be explained only by the fact that the Captain had not accepted any responsibility for the safe conduct of the child, nor did he wish to come to grips with his convict sailors, so he just let them torment Peter until he was little more than a wild animal by the time the ship docked in Boston Harbor.

The Captain told his friends the story and the mother fortunately took pity on the child and accepted him into her own family where his former life and training gradually came back to him. She often talked to him and asked him questions about his home and mother. He always told the same story: his mama had died, then he had a new mama and she had a little baby so she could not take care of him and his sister, whose name was Margaret. They used to play

in the yard by the fountain until their nurse came to get them ready for dinner. And that is all he remembered. The Boston family kept him until he was about sixteen years old, when he became a soldier in the Revolution.

This is an entertaining legend in which many of the Bither family have a firm belief, but it may well be the product of a fertile imagination, founded on the spelling of Peter's name as Biter on the Revolutionary rolls. He stated in 1820 that he was 67 years of age, born in Portsmouth, England, and a resident of the United States for more than 45 years. Allowing plenty of latitude, he could not have been younger than 15 and may have been as old as 20 on coming to this country. At the time of his enlistment he was 22, so the facts do not seem to bear out the legend, and no mention has ever been made as to the name of the family which befriended him.

Peter served in the Revolution four years and one month, at New York, New Jersey and Pennsylvania. He wintered at Valley Forge and was in the Battle of Monmouth. His complete record may be found in volume 2, page 85 of "Massachusetts Soldiers and Sailors in the Revolution," Maine at that time being a part of Massachusetts.

Peter and Eunice lived in Limington, Limerick, Unity, and Freedom. They had eleven children, the first five born in Limington, the rest in Limerick. The six youngest were baptised at the Limington Congregational church, 3 Oct. 1804, by the Rev. Jonathan Atkinson. (REG. 99:200)

2. PETER-2 BITHER (Peter-1), born at Limington, 1 Aug. 1787, died at Charleston, 8 May 1877, (pension record). He married, first, at Limington, 4 Oct. 1807 (REG. 87:125), SALLY KILLBRATH as the name was spelled in the record, though Coolbreth and Coolbroth are the more common of its many variations. According to her age given in the census records she was born at Buxton 22 June 1788, daughter of Daniel and Elizabeth (Harmon) Coolbreth, and died at Charleston 31 March

1861 (pension record). He married, secondly, 30 Dec. 1861, Mrs. Elizabeth Cobb, widow of William. She died after 18 June 1878 when, at the age of 90, she applied for a pension.

In William D. Patterson's "Probate Records of Lincoln County, Maine" we find a possible reference to our Peter at the age of 10, in a will, probated in 1797, of one Mary Ford, widow of Woolwich, who gives and bequeaths "to Lydia Kelley, to Nathan Webb and to Peter Bitum a Lad that now lives with me each of them a Bible."

Peter served in the War of 1812 as a private in Capt. Rockliff's Co., Maine Militia; he was drafted at Unity 10-15 Sept. 1814, served to 25-30 Sept. 1814. He was a farmer, 5 ft. 10 in., light blue eyes, light brown hair, light complexion. He lived in Unity 8 years, Thorndike 3 years, Charleston 52 years. His widow was of Fairfield in 1878.

His first wife was the mother of all his children, whose names have been obtained from Federal Census Records, Maine Vital Records and, with corrections the "History of Lincoln, Penobscot Co., Maine" by Dana Willis Fellows:

3. JOHN JOHNSON-2 BYTHER (Peter-1), born at Limerick 23 Sept. 1792, married, perhaps about 1812, MARY____, whose age is given as 58 in the census of 1850. According to the Federal Census records, John J. Byther was a wheelwright and in 1820 he was of Belfast, Hancock Co., in 1830 of Blakesburg (now Bradford), Penobscot Co., in 1840 of Frankfort, Waldo Co., in 1850 and in 1860 of Searsport and in 1870 he and his wife are found in Stockton under the spelling of Biather, though most of his records have it Byther. Early vital records of most of these places have been lost or destroyed, and the few found contain none of the name. Hence the record of his children is very incomplete:

4. BENJAMIN-2 BITHER (Peter-1), born at Limerick 23 Sept. 1792, twin to John Johnson; died at Linneus, Aroostook Co., 9 Feb. 1871. He married at Unity, 19 Oct. 1814, ANNIE TYLER, born at Hiram 28 June 1797; died at Linneus, 14 March 1879, dau. of David and Rhoda (Libby) Tyler.

Benjamin served in the War of 1812. When he obtained a bounty land warrant in 1856 it is recorded he served in Lt. Benjamin Ratcliff's Co., Col. Hubert Moore's Reg't. Mass. Inf., discharged at Edgecomb. In the pension application of his widow his service is given as in Captain Josiah Libby's Co. at Unity, discharged at Wiscasset. Both in 1814, but no month stated.

His obituary in a local paper says: "At his decease he had 56 grandchildren and 10 great grand children. In 1832 he moved to Linneus, then an almost unbroken

wilderness, selected a lot of wild land and made a home for himself and family, where he resided at the time of his death. Mr. Bither was a good man, and being naturally religious, he was led to unite himself with a class of Christians in 1816, then known as 'The Christian Band,' and afterward he was for a few years a member of the Frewill Baptist Church. But being naturally a man accustomed to investigate things for himself, he soon became convinced of the error of his faith, and searching the scriptures daily for himself, he received greater light, and in 1829 renounced the doctrine of 'Endless Hell Torments' and embraced the cheering faith of the holiness and happiness of a worldwide humanity. There has never been an organized church of the Universalist faith in Linneus, with which he could become connected, yet he steadfastly maintained his soul-cheering faith even to the end, living a true Christian life, and leaving an example behind him that anyone may be proud to imitate. He had his senses until the last, realizing fully that the 'Valley of Shadows' was before him, and that he must soon, very soon, pass through to the other side, yet he was sustained by his noble faith and trust to meet it all with a Christian resignation. May that same all-clasping faith in God the Father, and Christ the Mediator, rest upon the bereaved widow in her old age and go with her through the Valley of Shadows. And may God's richest blessings rest upon all the mourning friends of the dear deceased."

Born at Limerick, 16 Feb. 1794. Nothing further has been found concerning him except in the Federal Census records where he is found in Belfast, Hancock Co. in 1820, with occupation of farmer, in Blakesburg, Penobscot County in 1830 and 1840, and in Bradford in 1850 with a wife PRISCILLA and three children. She is obviously a second wife because Maine death records of some of his older children give their mother as DORCAS BICKFORD.

6. ELISHA-2 BITHER (Peter-1)

Born at Limerick, 21 May 1796; d. at Unity, 30 May 1857 (pension record); mar. "on the Sabbath Day" Oct. 1814, at Unity (pension record); to REBECCA MITCHELL dau. of Joseph. She was born about 1799 (age 61 in 1860 census), and died after 8 June 1871 when she applied for a pension age 72.

Elisha served in the War of 1812 as a private in Capt. John Comings Co., Eastport, Maine; enlisted 12 Dec. 1812, discharged 7 Dec. 1813. Re-enlisted 7 Oct. 1814 to 8 March 1815. Pension record states they were married 8 years and 1 month when first child was born.

A letter to his brother in Maine reveals discouragement and homesickness, no doubt intensified by his grief over the death of a beloved older brother.

At home May 17, 1874

Dear Brother,

It is with sad feelings that I seat myself to rite (sic) you this Sunday evening. Death has again entered our family circle and taken away our dear brother Phineas. It was sad news indeed, Joseph.

You do not know how much rejoiced I would be to join the remainder of the family once more. Was it possible for me to do so, how soon would I be with you, but such is not to be as our crop is almost an entire failure.

We had one of the finest prospects you ever saw about the first of April and it has dried up on us in this locality. The grain is very good after you

get above Gregsons Mills.

Tylers is very good and the crop is good all over the state except in this poor miserable hole. Joseph, it breaks me flat as it is possible to be broke. I hardly know which way to turn now and am going to find some other business except raising grain on the San Joaquin.

Josephine and John are here with a very sick baby.. They had two Drs there today. It has typhoid and pneumonia and is teething so it is doubtful if it recovers. Tell Maria and family we deeply feel for them in their lonely hours.

I will rite her soon. Tel the boys to be good boys and be kind to their mother, take good care of the property they have accumulated and they will be all right. That they may do so is my prayer. I did think a few years ago it would be my lot to go first but God had ordered it otherwise and I have very good health. Cant do hard work but I am around all the time.

Joseph, you said you would come to California if I came home. I never want to see you come to this country except it be on a visit. You see more pleasure than we do I am sure. If you do not, I pity you. I was almost crazy when I saw my crop drying up but when I got your letter informing us of Phineas death I said it is enough we are alive and have our health and know how to work.

Rite and let us know how you are getting along.

They are waiting to go to Bortas (?) and I will close by asking you all to rite. Give our love and best respects to all. Tel your wife to rite.

RECORDS OF SOME UNIDENTIFIED BITHERS AND BYTHERS

WILLIAM THOMAS BITHER was born at Shelton, Wash., 22 May 1888; m. at Chehalis, Wash., 24 Nov. 1913, LAVERNE REDDICK, dau. of John H. and Carrie Algertie (Jones) Reddick. William T. has not been placed in the genealogy. His mother, whose maiden name was WHITE, died when his brother Harry was born. The father went to Canada and was never heard of again, and his sons did not even know his name. Either Peter or Wilbur G., sons of Amos Tibbatts Bither (#7), could have been his ancestors; both disappeared from Maine, as did their younger brother Allan Amos, who was found in Oregon. At the time of William's birth, no vital records were kept in the state of Washington, and the 1930 census for Shelton has no Bithers.

As John J. Bither (as it is spelled here) also appears in a deed of the same year, it seems probable that James is one of his sons.

who could be his father was born in Bradford, but Joseph-2 (Peter) lived there as a young man, and a son might well think he had been born there, or not knowing where he had been born, named the place where he'd lived. Bradford was first called Bleakshurg. The census of 1870 mentions Joseph, age 36, and Sibbell, age 30. They may have been the parents of Elroy, though it was first thought that "Sibbell" was Joseph's daughter, born about 1822, as 1870 and 1880 records give and one born about that date.

EMER and MARY (GIBBARD) BICKER had a son Hayward, b. 25 Nov. 1812, d. 27 Jan. 1873, in Bradford. His father was the son of Charles B. (1773) ?

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This brings to an end, but by no means completes, the genealogy. Wanted especially are missing dates, middle names, information as to the parentage of wives, data on occupations and service records, marriages of children.
