Daphne's Hooks Cover

(original design by Daphne Mah)





Materials used:

- Susan Bates H8 & hook 3/0
- Red Heart (blue) MC
- Sport weight yarn (Minlon)
- green & yellow (for flower)
- Snap button
- Tapestry needle
- Sewing needle and thread

Stitches used:

Sc : single crochet SI st : slip stitch Inc sc : increase sc Dec sc : decrease sc Back Ip : Back loop

Rev sc : Reverse single crochet

Note:

Can be made to accommodate any pieces of hooks you intend to make it for. Instruction here is for 8 hooks i.e {starting chs for 8 hooks : (8hooks x 2) + 4ch = 20 chs}

Start each row with ch1, unless specified. Join each round with sl st, unless specified. Pattern Instruction Daphne's Hooks Cover

Instruction:

Row 1: With MC & hook H8, ch20, sc into 2nd ch from hook, 1sc each

into next 18chs (19sc)

Row 2 - 9: Sc into each st across. (19sc)

Row 10: 1sc into each first 2sc, work (sc into back lp of next sc, sc into


next sc) 8x, 1sc each into last 2sc. (19st)

Row 11 - 19: Sc into each st across. (19sc)

Row 20: 1sc into each first 2sc, work (sc into back lp of next sc, sc into

next sc) 8x, 1sc each into last 2sc. (19st)

Row 21 - 27: Sc into each st across. (19sc) Fasten and break off yarn, weave in loose end.



Bottom piece:

Row 1: With MC & hook H8, ch20, sc into 2nd ch from hook, 1sc each

into next 18chs (19sc)

Row 2 - 7: Sc into each st across. (19sc) Fasten and break off yarn. Weave in loose end.

Upper piece:

Row 1: With MC & hook H8, ch20, sc into 2nd ch from hook, 1sc each

into next 18chs. (19sc)

Row 2 - 3: Sc into each st across. (19sc)
Row 4 - 5: Dec sc at both ends. (17sc, 15sc)
Fasten and break off varn. Weave in loose end.

Joining:

(Note: right side is the 'inside', wrong side is the 'outside' of the Hooks Cover)

With wrong side of main piece facing, while holding bottom piece as in picture (and upper piece, when you are working sc near the upper corner of main piece), join all pieces together (starting at point marked 'X' in Diagram 1) by working sc across both thickness and around main piece as 'Step 1' of Diagram 1.

Rev sc into each sc around (take note to rev sc on the 6 front lps only from row 17- row 12, where the button flap is supposed to be, as in Diagram 1). Fasten and break off yarn. Weave in loose end.

Button flap:

Row 1: With MC & hook H8, join yarn with sl st to free lp of row 17 (as in

Diagram 1), sc into same lp, 1sc each into next 5 free lps. (6sc)

Row 2: Dec sc at both ends. (4sc) Row 3: Work (sc, dec sc, sc). (3sc)

Row 4: Work (Inc sc, sc, inc sc). (5sc)

Row 5: 1sc each into first 2sc, inc sc, 1sc each into last 2sc. (6sc)

Row 6: Inc sc at both ends. (8sc)

Row 7 - 9: Dec sc at both ends. (6sc, 4sc, 2sc) Fasten and break off yarn. Weave in loose end.

Flower:

Rnd 1: With Yellow Minlon and Hook 3/0, ch2, 5sc into 2nd ch from hook, sl st to first sc. (5sc)

Fasten and break off yarn, weave in loose end.

Rnd 2: Join Green Minlon with sl st to any sc, (ch2, 2-dc puff into same st, ch2, sl st to next st) 5 times to form 5-petals of flower.

Fasten and break off yarn, leaving long end for sewing to button flap.

Finishing:

Join yarn to point marked 'Y' in Diagram 1 and rev sc around button flap. Fasten and break off yarn. Weave in loose end.

Sew snap button to button flap and corresponding side of Hooks Cover as in picture. Sew flower to button flap.
