MINUTES OF THE BOARD MEETING

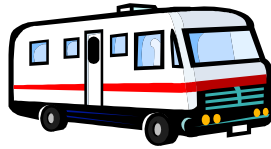
The next Board Meeting will be Tuesday, September 13, 2005. The Board on meets every other month and here is the schedule for the 2005-2006 CRA year.

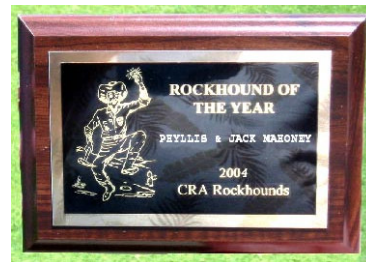
