SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Showing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included or they will be rejected.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries WILL NOT be accepted. Fax entries will be accepted. See instructions elsewhere in this premium list.
3. Post-dated cheques ARE NOT acceptable. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. **A \$20.00 SERVICE CHARGE WILL BE LEVIED ON ALL N.S.F. CHEQUES.**
4. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick, lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, in season or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly.
5. Obedience entry fees WILL gladly be refunded to exhibitors whose bitches are in season during our TRIALS and must be withdrawn, IF (a) a dated veterinarian's certificate is produced prior to the Trial, OR (b) the bitch is on hand for inspection in the show building prior to the Trial.
6. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone, but MUST BE FOLLOWED UP IN WRITING to the Show Secretary so as to be received no more than 7 days after closing.
7. The entry of any dog cannot be altered or canceled after entries close, except as provided in the Dog Show Rules.
8. After the closing of entries, an identification/receipt and judging schedule will be mailed to each exhibitor or agent. Owners making entries please include agent's address.
9. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
10. A judge officiating at a show held under the Dog Show Rules shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.
11. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dog, exhibitor or patron. A watchman will be on duty on Friday and Saturday nights, but it must be understood that the presence of the watchman is a courtesy to the exhibitor. The Hub City Kennel & Obedience Club will not be liable for any loss or injury that may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft, and/or death of dogs entered in the show under any circumstances.
12. The show building will be open at 6:30 a.m. each day.
13. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
14. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Chapter 24, Section 6, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules states "Any person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and the obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out."
15. ACCORDING TO CITY BYLAW, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF LEAD WITHIN CITY LIMITS. Exercise dogs only in designated areas. Anyone not following stoop and scoop policy will be excused from the show.

EXHIBITORS ARE REQUESTED TO COMPLETE SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS FOR CONFORMATION AND OBEDIENCE. We will accept one entry form per dog for all days. Please state dates to be shown. Entries must be typed or distinctly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on the entry forms. The Hub City Kennel & Obedience Club does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information, or errors due to illegibility of information on an entry form submitted by the owner or owner's agent, or entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to enter or compete.

An entry must be signed by the owner or agent or the entry will not be accepted.

Entry forms must be in the same size and format as those provided or they will be rejected.

FAX ENTRIES

Fax entries will be accepted. The number for transmission of Fax entries is **(306) 651-3163**. Fax entries **MUST** be accompanied by your VISA or MASTERCARD number and expiry date, name of cardholder and cardholder's signature. **PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY** as the Fax tends to blur the information. A charge of \$1.00 per entry pre day will be assessed for this service. **Entries made within 48 hours of the closing date will be assessed an additional charge of \$5.00 per entry form.**

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 20

Champions and Championship points

SECTION 1. A dog awarded winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 1 to 5), and the determinant of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	10 to 12	13+
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of championship points by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex, and then consult the schedule set forth above. This system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group as listed below:

BREEDS COMPETING AT GROUP LEVEL	DOG PLACED FIRST	DOG PLACED SECOND	DOG PLACED THIRD	DOG PLACED FOURTH
13 or more breeds	5	4	3	2
10 to 12 breeds	4	3	2	1
6 to 9 breeds	3	2	1	1
less than 6 breeds	2	1	1	1

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

NOTICE TO U.S. EXHIBITORS re ERN NUMBERS

Effective January 1, 1992 all dogs that are foreign born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-born and foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number.

To obtain an ERN number, mail or Fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or Visa/Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholder's name & signature. Provide your complete address for return of the ERN. Cost: \$53.50 This Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

The remainder of the entry fees will be retained to defray the costs.

YOUTH SWEEPSTAKES

Only dogs up to 18 months of age are eligible and these dogs must also be entered in the regular show. Dogs holding a Championship title MAY compete.

Sweepstakes classes are divided by sex and are offered as follows:

- Over 6 months but under 9 months of age on the day of the show.
- Over 9 months but under 12 months of age on the day of the show.
- Over 12 months but under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

Class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Dogs entered for sweepstakes must be entered in regular classes or for Exhibition Only.

Classes are offered as follows (sexes combined):

- Over 7 years and up to 9 years
- 10 years and over

The winner of each class will compete for BEST VETERAN IN SWEEPSTAKES.

SASKATOON AREA SHETLAND SHEEPDOG ASSOCIATION will hold an Obedience Booster with the HCKOC Trial on Friday. The following awards will be made based on Qualifying scores by a Shetland Sheepdog. High Score in Trial – Rosette & Trophy, High Score in each Class – Rosette & Trophy, High Score S.A.S.S.A. member – Banner. Each Qualifying Score by a Shetland Sheepdog – Award.

THE SASKATCHEWAN SIGHTHOUND ASSOCIATION will boost all Sighthound breeds on Saturday. Rosettes & trophies are offered for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy in Breed. A Rosette & prize is offered for the Highest Qualifying Score earned by a Sighthound in the trial on Saturday. Donations may be sent to the Show Secretary.
