The following classes (divided by sex) will be provided in this Specialty:

Regular Conformation Classes: Junior Puppy, Senior Puppy, 12-18 Months, Canadian Bred, Bred by Exhibitor, Open, Specials Only, Veterans (all dogs 7 years old or older on the day of the show) first place male and female compete for Best of Breed, no Winners points (can be neutered/spayed), Exhibition Only.

Altered Class: Entrants must be spayed or neutered. Altered Male, Altered Female - One winner picked from each class competes for Best Altered and Best Altered Opposite Sex.

Unofficial Classes:

Sire & Get - Any sire and 2 or more of his offspring.

Please attach list of Get/Progeny to the Sire's entry form or Dam's entry form.

Dam & Progeny - Any dam and 2 or more of her offspring.

Conformation Brace - Any 2 dogs of either sex having the same owner. Please attach the information for the second dog to the first dog's entry form.

Parades:

Parade of Champions - Any dog which has achieved it's championship may be entered.

Parade of Title Holders-Any dog which has achieved an obedience title may be entered.

Parade of Veterans - Any dog which is 7 years old or older by the day of the show.

CKC DOG SHOW RULES -- CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1 A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 - 5), and in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded winners shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of points to be awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or More
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the number of Championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly for the highest of the following breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, or Best of Breed and consult the schedule set forth above. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

NOTE: Each day of a championship is a new show, allowing a dog to earn up to five points a day. A specialty is also considered a separate show for that breed or breeds and an additional set of points can be earned that day if the dog is entered in the specialty and in the all breed show.

NOTICE TO ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS -- EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

Effective January 1, 1994, the cost to obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN) with the CKC has been increased to \$53.50 Canadian. To obtain an ERN:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN.
- Include payment in the full amount.
- Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa, or Mastercard. For Nonmembers please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Nonresidents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates.
- Provide a full return address.
- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure that the Visa or Mastercard number is legible and expiry date and signature included.

An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension.
