The first technical dinner meeting of the year 2000-2001 was held at the Dhahran International Hotel on November 12, 2000. The meeting was well attended with more than 70 members and other professionals present. Saudi Aramco sponsored the meeting. The meeting started with



a welcome speech by Dr. Abdulaziz Bub-shait, Arabian Gulf Section (AGS) President, where he highlighted the activities of the Section. One of the highlights of his speech was the announcement that of the 12 candidates, that appeared for the July 2000 AACE Certification Examination held at Dhahran, 10 candidates had passed the examination.



Dr. Abdulaziz Bub-shait presented certificates of completion the Spring Cost Engineering course offered by the AGS to the students. The guest speaker for the evening was **Noman Zaheer** from the Department of Engineering and Management, KFUPM. He gave a very interesting presentation on the "**Use of Simulation in Cost Estimating**". He spoke on simulation's use in estimation, which is potentially superior technique than anything in use presently in industry, and its cons and pros. The presentation covered an array of tools



available for the purpose of simulation. Noman presented **STROBOSCOPE** as an application used by him for simulation. The presentation was well received by the audience and their interest in the subject matter was obvious by the number of questions that followed.

Fred stated that your or your Company's web page is a "window to the world" through which you can communicate with the rest of the world and anyone from anywhere can see a glimpse of your Company.

The workshop gave a step-by-step instruction in creating a web page for your company or a personal home page and also provided hints on how you can easily publish and promote your web page on the Internet. No special software is required other than the basic Microsoft products or Netscape, which are available to all PC users.

CERTIFICATION EXAMINATION AN ACHIEVEMENT

The Section held the November Certification Examination simultaneously at two locations for the first time, which was a significant achievement. In the past, we have been holding the examination only at the Saudi Aramco Training Institute at Dhahran. This year the Section was approached to hold the examination at a location outside Saudi Arabia for students of the Gulf Region that could not enter Saudi Arabia to sit for the examination. Saudi Aramco, ITC, Dhahran North was our regular site. Two candidates from Zuhair Co. & Zamil Steel took the written examination, which was held on Thursday, 23rd November 2000 from 7:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Candidates also submitted 2500 word technical papers as part of the Certification requirement.

The following Certified Cost Engineers proctored the exam at Dhahran: Mubashir Q. Mirza, CCE, Bader M. Ahmed, CCE, Mohammed V. Moideen, CCE and M. Imran Ashgar, CCE.

Bahrain was selected as the other site outside Saudi Arabia since it was the most convenient location for our representatives to be present to proctor the examination. The examination was held at the Bahrain Society of Engineers office and Hassan Al-Somali volunteered to proctor the examination. His effort in holding the examination is appreciated.



This is a first step in our effort to reach out and support our members that are Out-Of-Kingdom. In future, we could plan some of our other activities outside of Saudi Arabia. Three candidates from United Arab Emirates and Oman registered for the exam.

The Section appreciates Saudi Aramco and the Bahrain Society of Engineers support in providing office space to hold the certification examination.
