Tender Loving Care

- In life we have a NEED
 Basic NEED: clothing, shelter, food/water, People
- Time will come when there will be separation; Jesus will separate the sheep from the goats; those righteous from the unrighteous
- There should be love, concern, care... WHO NEEDS CARE?
 Everyone...those who are least among you
- Responsive Reading: Parable of the Good Samaritan
- Many people don't go out of their way to show care, concern, love
- Everyone needs TLC
- Jesus had ministry of CARING for people

Reflective Questions:

- Who is your neighbor? Are you tied up with your time?*
- Do you have time to show care, concern, love?*
- Let others know you care
- Are you a believer or a pretender? Are you genuine?
- Real evidence of a person's belief is how he/she acts
- To prove you are a believer, you need to ACT! “Love your neighbor as yourself”
- What we say and do should MATCH
- How well do our Actions separate from being a believer/pretender?
- Sin of commission-when you do wrong & you know it's wrong
- Sin of Omission- when you sin & you don't know
- CHALLENGE: Have the eyes of Jesus that is loving/caring
