Tasks

Checking the meaning of terms Matching the titles of e-mails with the body of the e-mail Identifying words and phrases from the e-mails Discussing points arising from the e-mails

How to use the lesson

1 Ask students what they know about the World Trade Organisation. Ask students to look at the list of issues and to discuss their meanings in pairs. Be prepared to help if questions arise as some of the concepts are quite difficult to explain.

2 Ask students to skim the e-mails to the WTO and choose a title for each mail from the box in 1.

- 3 Ask students to find words or phrases in the e-mails with the meanings given.

- 4 Students discuss the questions in groups, then report their ideas to the class. Hold a class feedback session.
