1. **Access** - obtain, examine, or retrieve (data or a file)
2. **Addiction** - the fact or condition of being addicted to a particular substance, thing, or activity.
3. **Antenna** - a rod, wire, or other device used to transmit or receive radio or television signals.
4. **Anxiety** - a nervous disorder characterized by a state of excessive uneasiness and apprehension, typically with compulsive behavior or panic attacks.
5. **Cellular Phone** - a telephone with access to a cellular radio system so it can be used over a wide area, without a physical connection to a network.
6. **Dependence** - the state of relying on or being controlled by someone or something else.
7. **Depressed** - (of a person) in a state of general unhappiness or despondency.
8. **Extrovert** - an outgoing, overtly expressive person.
9. **Introvert** - a shy, reticent person.
10. **Isolated** - having minimal contact or little in common with others.
11. **Mobile Telephone** - a telephone with access to a cellular radio system so it can be used over a wide area, without a physical connection to a network.
12. **Nomophobia** - the irrational fear of being without your mobile phone or being unable to use your phone.
13. **Notification** - the action of notifying someone or something.
14. **Obsession** - an idea or thought that continually preoccupies or intrudes on a person's mind.
15. **Phobia** - an extreme or irrational fear of or aversion to something.
16. **Social Communication** - engage effectively in joint attention and sharing of emotions and experiences with others in a social interaction.
17. **Statistic** - a fact or piece of data from a study of a large quantity of numerical data.
18. **Suicide** - the act or an instance of taking one's own life voluntarily and intentionally.
19. **Technology** - machinery and equipment developed from the application of scientific knowledge.

20. Text Messaging - an electronic communication sent and received by mobile phone.
