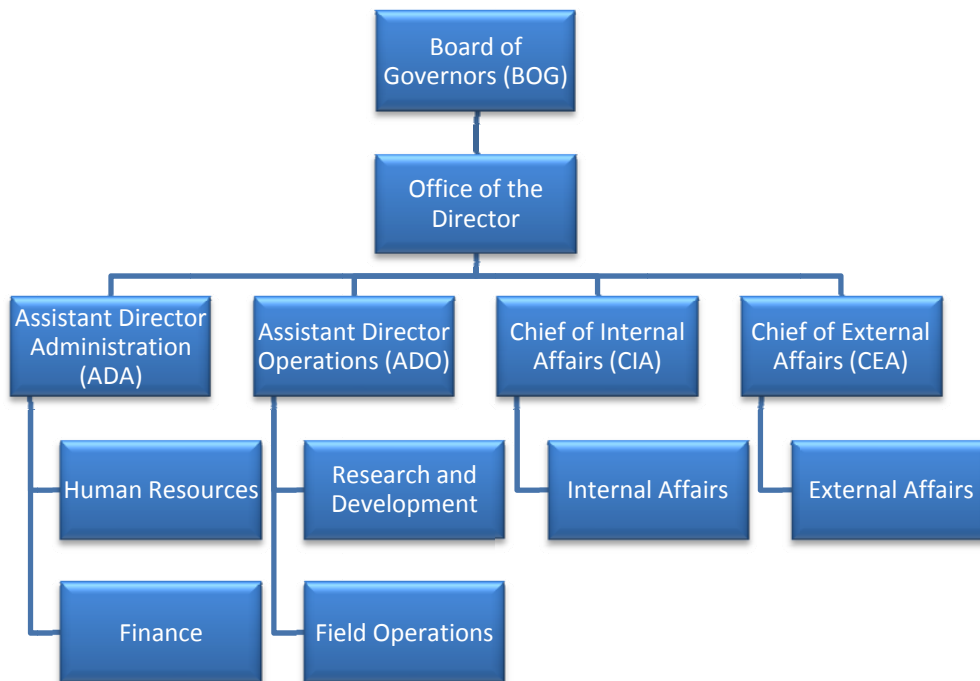


Upper Canadian Investigations Org Chart



Operations within UCI follow rigid bureaucratic procedures. At the top of hierarchy is the BOG. Members of the BOG include the Prime Minister and the Ministers of National Defence and Public Safety. Other ministers are brought in as circumstances require. The Director guides his four assistants in overall operations and is the final court of appeal in any internal disputes. His four assistants oversee the direct operations of their departments. The ADA oversees the day-to-day operations of the office itself. The ADA departments take of human resources, benefits, supplies, travel arrangements and the like. The ADO oversees all research and development and most field operations. The CIA looks after the safety of the UCI's facilities and keeps ever-vigilant watch on employees of the UCI to make sure they don't switch sides or go insane without permission. The CEA looks after all liaisons with other Canadian government operations, foreign governments or any relations with non-human nations. Both the CIA and the CEA have field agents which is a source of on-going friction between their offices and the ADO.
