(10 points, due Thur.) Provide a detailed answer for each of the following questions. You may answer on the reverse side of this sheet or on another sheet of paper. The first person to turn this sheet in with one question answered correctly gets full credit.

- 1) Describe two main points that the article is trying to get across.**
- 2) How does the title of the story indicate what the story is about?**
- 3) The subheading indicates that MySpace.com is “redefining the term “fan club” for millions of kids and millions of fans.” How is it doing that?**
- 4) The article uses a single person to exhibit how typical people use MySpace. What is the name of this person, what is the screen name of this person, and how does this person differ from you?**
- 5) What has been the reaction to MySpace by the entertainment community? Use a specific example to support your answer.**
- 6) The article describes the effects that MySpace has had on a number of bands and performers. Name six of the artists that are mentioned as having benefited from MySpace.**
- 7) How does MySpace intend to expand in the future? What uses, other than as a communication tool between friends, do you MySpace being able to provide in the future?**
- 8) In the eighth paragraph on page 54, the word “naysayers” is used. Using the words around it, define the word *naysayers*.**
- 9) As was mentioned in the article, Erik Ahad blames MySpace for something. What is it that he is upset about and is he justified?**
- 10) “His voice sounds as sweet as Oreos and ice cold milk” is an example of what type of figurative language?**
