

Glossary

Animal: a living organism that feeds on organic matter, typically having specialized sense organs and nervous system and able to respond rapidly to stimuli (Animals like spiders).

Euthanasia: the painless killing of a patient suffering from an incurable and painful disease or in an irreversible coma. The practice is illegal in most countries.

Pain: physical suffering or discomfort caused by illness or injury.

Refinement: the process of removing impurities or unwanted elements from a substance.

Welfare: the health, happiness, and fortunes of a person or group.

Experimentation: the process of performing a scientific procedure, especially in a laboratory, to determine something.

Cruelty: callous indifference to or pleasure in causing pain and suffering.

Activism: the policy or action of using vigorous campaigning to bring about political or social change.

Soviet: an elected local, district, or national council in the former Soviet Union.

Organ Transplant: a surgical operation in which a failing or damaged organ in the human body is removed and replaced with a functioning one.
