

BHJMTC would like to invite BMBC to participate in the planned enduro sprint day on Sunday the 17th August at Marsden park

The Event

1. The day will be run under mini enduro sprint format. With riders completing a determined number of timed laps of the course (aiming for 6-7 plus a sighting lap)
2. It is expected that the course will take 8-10 minutes to complete
3. The course will include part of both MX tracks, bushland, and existing licensed enduro loop - sample map is attached
4. We will require a number of marshalls throughout the course, however will also require 6-8 parents to act as sweep riders
5. We will have electronic timing, however as a backup we may revert to manual timing to the nearest second (remember this should be a fun event and we are not racing for sheep stations)
6. The event will only run in DRY weather (our experience tells us that the enduro areas do not hold up well with rain, some areas become impassible) If the weather is not great we will publish updates on our website on the Saturday evening - all riders should check if in doubt - please mention this to your riders at you club day this weekend
7. The 85cc/65cc event areas will be used as an open pit for the event
8. The bottom carpark will be unavailable (as it will become part of the competition area and cannot be fenced) so we will have to park tight in the main carpark and up the driveway (maybe even around the 50's clover area)

Grading

1. Riders will compete in their minikhana championship grades (nippers through to junior and senior)
2. Nippers will compete, though their course will be shortened according to the GCR's
3. 50cc through to Snr will ride the same course
4. For the first lap riders will be organised by a penciller from each club and sent out roughly in fastest to slowest order, after that riders will run according to the times in the first lap

Administration

1. The event is open to ALL members of BHJMTC and BMBC
2. There will be no entry form, riders can enter on the day. We will be relying someone from BMBC to sign in their members
3. The cost per rider will be as per our standard ride day fees (\$20, \$15, \$10 for each rider thereafter)
4. We do not intend to run a canteen and therefore offer the opportunity to BMBC to run either a full canteen or sausage sizzle and drinks..
