**Girl Scouts of the USA Identification Strip**

Place this strip just below the shoulder line on the insignia sash. Place this strip just below the shoulder seam on the right side of the Brownie Girl Scout vest. The strip shows that you belong to Girl Scouts of the USA. The Brownie Girl Scout identification strips are brown, with a brown border.

**Girl Scout Council Identification Strip**

Place this strip directly below the Girl Scouts of the USA identification strip. Every council has its own identification strip.



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**Brownie Girl Scout Try-Its**

Wear Brownie Girl Scout Try-Its on the vest or sash below the membership stars, placed as received, horizontally in rows of four or five. Arrange Try-Its on the left and right sides of the vest to achieve a balanced appearance. They can also be continued around the bottom of the vest to the back. Each Brownie Girl Scout Try-It represents completion of activities in an area of interest.
