Range Finder (EX 89)	Can be used to check which cells are referenced in the formula assigned to the active cell	I have never used this before
comma style format (EX 98)	Inserts a comma every three positions to the left of a decimal point and causes numbers to be displayed to the nearest hundredths	I sometimes use this
currency style format (EX 98)	Displays numbers with a dollar sign to the left of the number, inserts a comma every three positions to the left of the decimal point, and displays numbers to the nearest cent	I don't know what this is
fixed dollar sign (EX 98)	Far left in the cell, often with spaces between it and the first digit	I now use this
floating dollar sign (EX 98)	Appears immediately to the left of the first digit with no spaces	I now use this
condition (EX 104)	Made up of two values and a relational operator and is true or false for each cell in the range	I don't know what this is
best fit (EX 107)	The width of the column will be increased or decreased so the widest entry will fit in the column	I know what this is
character (EX 107)	A letter, number, symbol, or punctuation mark	I sometimes use this
pixel (EX 107) hiding cells (EX 109)	A dot on the screen that contains a color.	I've rarely used this
hiding cells (EX 109)	A technique you can use to hide data that might not be relevant to a particular report or sensitive data that you do not want others to see	I've rarely used this

spell checker (EX 111)	Used to check the worksheet for spelling errors	I use this a lot of the time
