

Christ Church gets gifts from alumni association

CHRIST Church Secondary School received 700 jerseys from New York based, Guyana Alumni Association Inc., which will be sold to purchase text, books for students of the school.

The announcement was made at the school, Middle Street, Georgetown on Friday afternoon, when a small gathering of past and present students along with teachers, also heard that all efforts are being made to ensure that the students receive the best quality education.

Headmistress of the School, Ms. Debra Da Silva, explained that the donation was made by the association after a fundraising event was held in New York, to purchase the jerseys.

"We are very grateful for the assistance. Our school will be celebrating its 40th anniversary on September 13, and this gift will indeed take us a long way," she said.

According to Old Students Association member, Mr. Leo Ramalho, another fundraising activity, which is also expected to be held in New York, is on stream, and the proceeds from that event, will be used to purchase at least five computers for the school.

"These t-shirts, which carry our school logo, will be sold for \$1,000 each and the money will be used to buy text books for fourth and fifth form students, who can't afford to make such purchases," he said.
