

## PLAYOFF FORMATS

## CANADIAN SHUFFLEBOARD CONGRESS PLAYOFFS

Passed at 1988 AGM

The Canadian Championship Tournament shall be a double round robin series. Zone or Charter Associations may alter this format at their discretion.

The National Championships will be played over a period of three days, with the finals of each event to be played on the fourth day. The playoff format shall be as follows:

- (a) The top three teams shall advance to the playoffs.
- (b) The top team shall have a bye to the final.
- (c) The finals shall be a best-of-three series.
- (d) The second and third place teams shall play a best-of-three semi-final series on the same day of the event (if possible).
- (e) If more than three teams qualify, a sudden death single game playoff on the same day of the event will determine the team to advance to the final or semi-finals. i.e. If two or more teams are tied for first, a single elimination draw played on the same day of the event shall determine first place. Similarly, if three or more teams are tied for second, a single elimination draw shall determine the two teams who will play in the semi-finals

Note: The Aggregate Points are determined after the double round robin is finished.
