Minutes of the Monthly Meeting of Cedar Grove & District Riding Club 12/08/09

Meeting opened at: 7.10pm - held at S. Ashwood's home.

Minutes: Minutes of previous meeting (July) were read. Moved C. Mackie, seconded D. Morris as a true and correct record.

Business Arising from minutes:

- * Come and Try Us SJ days 12th and 13th September. Saturday for members, Sunday open. Ads have gone in papers.
- * Open SJ 9th August - approx 30 riders. 4 in 6 bar. Day well received. Cath was CB and judge.
- * Woollies Fund Raisers 16th August – only Sharon and Cath doing it. From email to members only one member responded. Will be run between 9 to 1pm. Next Woollies Fund Raiser is in September.
- * Quotes for shed have been forwarded to Cr Ban. Meeting to be organized with J. Vogler from LCC once arenas completed replacement of shed.
- * Sharon has organized monster raffle. Run for rest of year and draw at end of year trophy presentation.

Correspondence & Business Arising from correspondence: Nil as secretary not present.

Treasurer's Report: Nil as treasurer not present.

Showjumping Report:

- * Jumping Equitation training day for members only – 22nd August. Will be conducted by C. Mackie. 4 x 1½ hour groups - \$25 per rider with \$5 to the club. Catherine to do programme and get Michelle to email to members ASAP 9am start
- * Jumping Equitation training day for members only - 1st November – internal SJ competition 29th November – open SJ Competition.

Dressage Report:

- * Reconstruction of arenas going well. Greg has asked if club could afford to purchase same sand that ELD uses. Club has been quoted \$30 a tonne. New sand is \$38 a tonne and we need 40 tonne. Cost – \$3500 more. Meeting agreed subject to balance of committee's approval (by email) due to no quorum.
- * Programme for open associate day – Sharon to do and start chasing judges. ? Put levies for ground maintenance etc. Discussed green protection fencing to stop erosion around new arenas ? Take down for event or make very secure.
- * Members want another internal dressage day – 27th September.

Hack Report:

Hack show – two ring circus plus beginner ring on 11th October. Kay suggested they run similar to PRARG's day in September. Catherine to do programme. Discussed use of arenas for warm up and area for lunging.

General Business:

- * Secretary of club has not been attending meetings and no correspondence etc available. Coming up in September will be renewal for EFA insurance etc. Catherine to contact secretary to discuss.
- * Results from club competitions not on web site – Catherine to look into.
- * Criteria for end of year trophies – Catherine to send to Michelle for next newsletter. Catherine would like to introduce a new trophy i.e. member of the year or similar. Decided to introduce a President's trophy which will be a perpetual. Kay has offered a box of donated trophies for Cedar Grove/pony club/PRARG to use. Catherine will select some trophies.

Meeting closed at 8.10pm. Next meeting 9th September.

IMPORTANT...PLEASE READ, latest news!**HENDRA ALERT**

Biosecurity Queensland has recently confirmed a case of Hendra virus at a property at Cawarral, near Rockhampton. Officers from Biosecurity Queensland are working with the property owners to take samples from the horses onsite and obtain more information such as the movements of other horses from the property. The horse died on Saturday, 8 August 2009 after a short illness. Queensland Primary Industries and Fisheries (QPIF), Biosecurity Queensland, QPIF was alerted by a call from a vet to the Disease Watch Hotline. Two other horses are reported as having died at the property in the last 10 days – a filly (28 July 2009) and a pony (7 August 2009). Both horses were visited by private practitioners. Hendra virus was not suspected in either case at the time.

The property is an 'equine nursery' that offers breeding services and yearling preparation. There are 23 horses on the property, including two foals. One of the foals is reported as not well. All horses are of either Thoroughbred or Anglo Arabian breed. A Biosecurity Queensland veterinarian was dispatched to the property from Rockhampton on Saturday 7 August 2009 and collected sample (blood, nasal swab and salivary glands). The samples were couriered to the Biosecurity Sciences Laboratory in Brisbane and left Rockhampton on a flight on Sunday afternoon. The property was quarantined as a precaution on Saturday. A neighbouring Property with an in contact (nose to nose) horse was also quarantined. The dead horse was disposed of on the property by deep burial.

Horses on both quarantined properties will be examined and sampled today. Detailed information has been gathered including details of the horses on the property, the adjoining properties and any places where horses from this property have moved to in recent weeks (tracing). As a precaution tracing was undertaken from 21 days before the death of the first horse. Tracing of horses that have left the property is in progress. They are to be subject to health testing. There have been no reports of ill health in these horses to date. The local Queensland Health (Population Health) contact was contacted on Saturday afternoon and was advised of the situation and the potential for human contact with infected horses and bodily fluids. Human health considerations are being managed through Queensland Health.

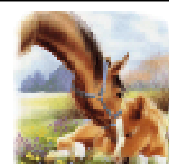
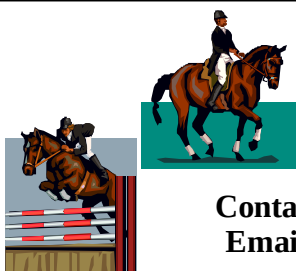
