ARTICLE ON DISORDER OF GRAZING HORSES

### .....Disorder of Grazing Horses.....

Grazing horses are susceptible to pasture based disorders Australia wide. Three that immediately spring to mind are -

(a) Injuries from awns or spines on headed cereal crops. These can have serious consequences, especially if in the eye region. Mature cereal crops, especially some species of triticale, barley, oats and wheat grow long awns that may cause damage to the lips, inner mouth (tongue and cheeks) or eyes. They may also cause of choke, although in many years of feeding horses I personally have not had a problem with any of my horses nor have I heard any reports of such, although it seems to be the norm to have this story go around - perhaps I am wrong or mistaken in my thinking and would appreciate any reports of such happenings.

(b) Sub-acute cyanide poisoning: some plant species (especially young growing sorghum varieties) synthesize cyanogenetic glucosides. These contain a cyanide group which can be released from the glucoside when the substance is fermented through microbial organism action in the hindgut. Johnson grass is another of the prime culprits that may contain concentrations of cyanogenetic concentrations which are high enough to cause ataxia, urinary incontinence and posthitis (inflammation of the prepuce) in horses.

(c) Osteodystrophia fibrosa: also known as 'Bighead', ODF, Nutritional Secondary Hyperparathyroidism, or NSH. This condition was first reported as an important grazing horse condition in Queensland in the late 1970s with horses grazing Buffel grass (research by McKenzie et.al. ARI, Yeerongpilly) showed that the cause was oxalic acid in buffel grass along with several other introduced sub-tropical species commonly grazed by pastured horses. These introduced grasses have high levels of oxalic acid that binds much of their calcium content. The amount of oxalate in forages varies with the age of the forage - it has been shown that young growth has the highest levels and these concentrations increase during wet weather and during the night phase.

Other grasses with high levels of oxalate are - Setaria, Kikikyu, Green panic, Paragrass and Pangola. There is little risk with native grasses, Rhodes grass or legumes (clovers etc.)

Symptoms of ODF are:

- (A) The early stage - A shifting lameness and arching of the back. The horse is lame but only mildly, and the horse may 'creak' in the joints when they walk.
- (B) More advanced - Fractures and sprains can occur and there is enlargement of the facial bones. At this stage, the animal may have difficulty in breathing, the sinuses may become affected and the horse may develop a cough - especially when stressed.
- (C) Advanced stage - The horse becomes thin and anaemic and may eventually die. Treatment for this condition is immediately removing the animal from the pasture and administering a Ca supplement. The condition is reversible provided it is not too far advanced.

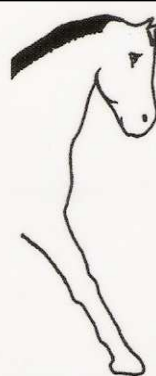

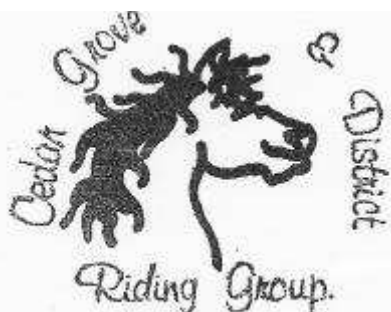
