The theme for the party is going to be COUNTRY of course, so everyone can put their cowboy boots and hat! Come on along and say 'Happy Birthday' and have fun!!



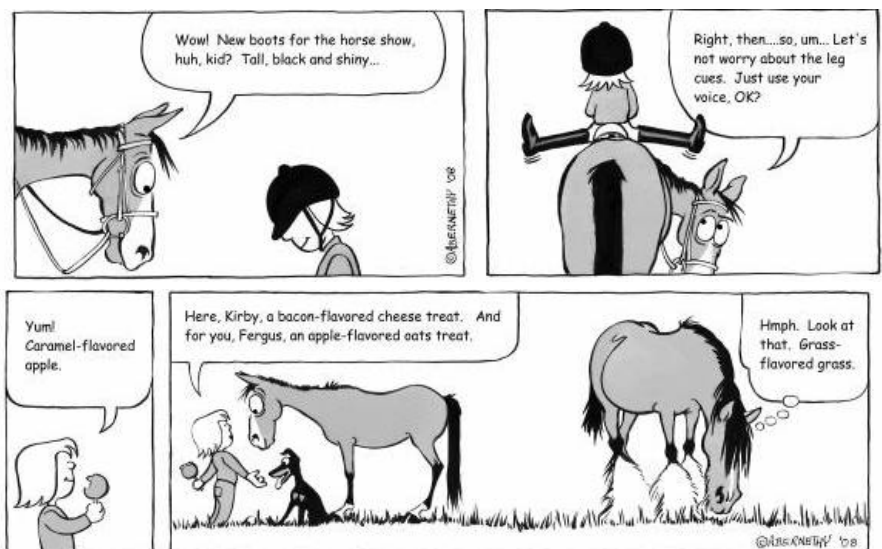
