Hi Everyone,

Hope you are all well and are having fun with your horses. This report is going to seem a bit blunt, but I feel the need to put a point across. We have been very lucky with the growth of our Club, in fact the figures show that we have an increase percentage of 100%. This sort of growth is going to benefit the Club in its portfolio in the future requests of Grant funding for projects, and we have some huge project ideas coming up. The cross country jumps are on the way, we have been asking for quotes for the cost of putting a roof and lights over our sand arena behind the Clubhouse, I have a wonderful vision of having our outside arenas lit up, more holding yards and a round yard. I have an idea for the day yards and the round yard, but more on that later.

The blunt part is about the fact we have 130 plus members, every time there is a day on, and we need people to help set up for these competitions, we get the same people turn up every time to help. What is the use of being part of a Club and not coming along to help out. I know people have different jobs and things to do and cannot come along all the time to help, it just seems to me and it is the same group of people who come to help. Next year you will be allocated jobs, these will be on the nomination forms. If you don't tick one, we will tick one for you and if you don't come and do your allocated job - **YOU DON'T RIDE!!!!**

I am sorry if this upset some people, and that it has come to this measure. The people that come and help all the time have lives too.

The idea I had for the new day yards and the round yard is that everyone sponsors a post or a rail or two rails or whatever you want to sponsor. This will cover the cost of materials and it will also show future Grants prospects that we are capable of raising funds ourselves and don't only rely on Grants to improve our facilities.

Well this has been a big report, and please I do appreciate gratefully what people do for our Club and I'm sure I have always thanked everyone that has helped us one way or another. Don't forget you can ring me to discuss something or simply come along to a meeting. Michelle always puts reminders out to let you all know when the next meetings are.

Happy riding to you all and please check out the calendar for the remainder of the year. Our next day is Saturday 20th, feed seminar with Peter Waller - I am really looking forward to this, I have already seen the results of this new feed and its method, so please come along and support this seminar 3pm at the Clubhouse.

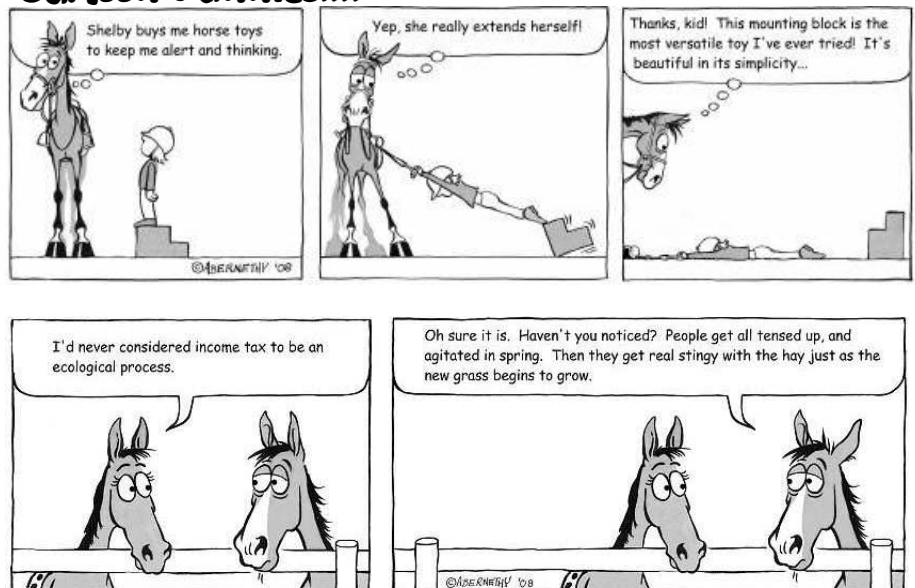

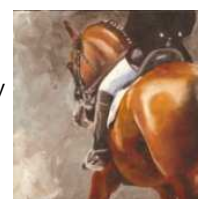


CG&DRC Shire Saddlery Open Dressage Day Report - 31st August

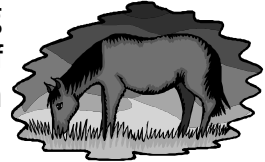

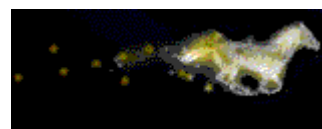

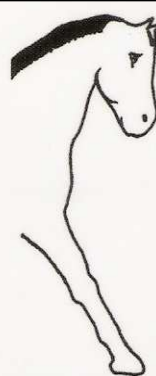
