## Minutes of the Monthly Meeting of Cedar Grove & District Riding Club 09/09/09

**Meeting opened at:** 7.10pm - held at Club grounds.

**Prior to commencement of meeting, C. Mackie introduced Greg Birkbeck, President of Logan Country Chamber of Commerce.** Greg spoke and answered questions for an hour outlining re-emergence of Chamber of Commerce since amalgamation of Shires. It is now bigger and better than previously. It is the biggest community group in Jimboomba area and is very keen to play a bridging role between sporting clubs and Logan City Council. Future plans, i.e. State Government footprint and impact on sports/acreage etc discussed. Cath said the club has lots of projects on the book but is not able to self fund the bigger projects. Leases discussed in general.

- \* Club secretary has resigned. Sharon to be temporary secretary until AGM.

- \* Dressage QLD request for 2010 dates - **action - Sharon to send in dates**
- \* EA insurance renewal - **action - Sharon & Anita to handle**
- \* Office of Fair Trading - not financial as not paid 2009 renewal - **action - pass onto Nancy Clarke and pay**

**Treasurer's Report:** - Anita apologized for not attending last meeting. Has only in last two weeks obtained audited books from 2008. Club is behind in getting books done. Nancy Clarke has come onboard to help. Need to chase up where bank statements are going. Kay offered to let club look at PRARG's excel system which is very easy to use and self calculating.

**Showjumping Report:** - Jumping Equitation training day for members only - 10<sup>th</sup> October. Will be conducted by C. Mackie. 4 x 1½ hour groups

**Dressage Report:** - Programmes out for Internal and Open Associate Day

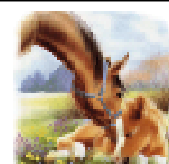
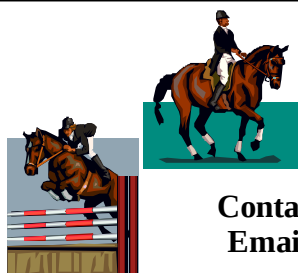
