Firstly to note that the Open Dressage day on the 30th March has been cancelled due to a clash with PRARG.

Secondly, when attending an event being held at the club a completed waybill and a declaration of health must be carried on person at all times. As well a copy of both must be supplied to the club. The club has obtained its own personal permit number that can be used by members when attending an event held by the club. To obtain this permit number please contact Sharon. However if you wish to use the facilities at the club on your own time a permit from the DPI must be obtained.

Finally if you attend an event at the club you must carry documentation containing the horse/s identification. This is needed as all horses have to be checked and proven they are the correct horse that is meant to be attending the competition before they can come on to club grounds. Information required is name, sex, colour, brands if applicable, markings, etc. The club will be starting a registry of horse's details so that horses can be identified.

Please anyone that can help out on the days of either the training day or the dressage day it would be appreciated. The more help we can get the better the days can run.

It is an important note that everyone should bring a bottle of disinfectant with them when they come to the club. I know that we have made a large progress with EI, but it is still important that we be on the safe side.
