September 1743 in New Orleans, Louisiana, daughter of ANTOINE AUFRERE and MATURINE GUILMOT. She was born December 27, 1728 in Dauphine, France, and died June 30, 1774 in St Charles Parish⁶.

The book "Histoire de la Louisiane", by Antoine Bernard cites a memorandum from Bienville, dated 15 Juin 1740, listing the names of his officers. deGruize is listed as a "cadet a aiguillette."

"A young French Officer, Antoine Valentin deGruy Verloin Dumenil Fouchard de la

Folie, arrived in the Illinois territory in 1741." (article from the Missouri Historical Review by Carl J. Ekberg, Vol 1, no. 2 Jan 1982.)

Antione Valentin De Gruy was a young French officer who came to Fort de Chartres near St. Louis in 1741. The French had been mining lead in Missouri since the 1720's. Carl J. Ekberg published a report in the Missouri Hist. Rev, 1982, based on a report of the two expeditions to Missouri Antoine led in 1743 to verify Indian reports of new lead deposits.

(People in History, Vol 1: A-M, an Index to U.S. and Canadian Biographies in History Journals and Dissertaions (Susan K. Kinnell, Editor))

The 2 volume book "Mississippi Valley Melange, A collection of Notes and Documents for the Geneology and History of the Province of Louisiana and the Territory of New Orleans, by Winston DeVille, contains excerpts of Governor Bienville's report on the Officers of the Louisiana Troops in 1740. He writes: "(Monsiuer) De Gruis: He served in France, and was in two campaigns there. He has been here for one year. He conducts himself very wisely and is very exacting toward his service, and has spirit; age 23."

4 April 1746: "Was present Mr. Antoine Valentin Degruyverloin, Lord Dumenil Fouchard, Ecuyer de la Folie, officer of a company of infantry of the detachment of the Marine garrisoned in Illinois, residing in the town of Kaskaskia, parish of the Immaculate Conception, ... " record of a property transfer (a house on a lot with a barn and a stable) to another officer Mr. Alexandre Duclos 13 March 1748: entry identifying the purchase by Degruyverloin, of a windmill' in partnership with his mother-in-law, Dame Maturine Guilmot d'Aufrere ("wife of Aufrere, merchant in New Orleans"). They bought the windmill for a sum of "three thousand in bonds of the King's domain and thirteen hundred pounds of flour" - Land Records from Randolph County Archives, (from the book The Village of Chartes in Colonial Illinois 1720-1765, edited by Margaret K. Brown and Lawrie C. Dean)

Antoine held the rank of "Enseigne en Second" in 1740. In 1746, his rank was "Enseigne en Pied". In 1752, he was "Lieutenant. In 1759, he was promoted to "Capitaine". (From the book The First Families of Louisiana, by Glenn R. Conrad, chapter: List of Officers who Served in Louisiana.) I believe he was at one time with the Marines Troop 401.

The book "Illinois on the Eve of the Seven Years' War 1747-1755, collections of the Illinois State Historical Library Volume XXIX, French Series, Volume III" published by the Illinois State Hist. Library, contains translations of numerous official letters sent between the Commandants of the Illinois post and the French Governors of Louisiana referencing Antoine DeGruy's escapades during the period. The letters provide insight into life at the French forts of the Illinois country and the interactions with the Indians and English.

During the 1750's, Antoine led expeditions into Indian country. Antoine appears to have become pretty heavily in debt and in two letters the commandant was writing for help in getting Antoine to pay his debts. Antoine seems to have been running a lead mine during 1752, with labor costs eating "up the little profit he might make." Finally, at the end of 1752, he reports that "M. deGruis has much lead at the mine to send. He hopes to get enough from it to satisfy (his debts) this fall." In one letter,

Mcarty (the commandant) writes how he is hoping Antoine will pay his debts (to M. Oliver) - "I hope as much of M. deGruis, who has much ore; but ambition and assays are ruining him."

In a letter from Kerlerec (governor of Louisiana) to Rouille, June 21, 1754, it appears that Antoine is finally producing: " I am addressing to M. de Macnamara, lieutenant general and commandant at Rochefort, a little packet which I beg him to have forwarded to you by the first occasion which presents itself. You will find in it copper ore from the mine which the Sieur deGruis has discovered in Illinois and which he is exploiting; he could not do it more slowly than he does on account of the shortage of his labor which consists I believe of one negro. ... The Sieur deGruis is asking an exclusive privilege for the exploitation of this mine; but he hopes at the same time that the king will advance him some negroes for which he will soon pay, putting himself in a situation to buy others."

The final letter mentioning the Sieur deGruis, in late 1754, was again from governor Kerlerec requesting workmen from France to help Antoine and his now partner, the Sieur de la Gautrais, to work the mines.

In a footnote, the following information is listed: "Antoine Valentine deGruis Verloin. Ensign en second, October 1, 1740; ensign en pied, June 1, 1746; lieutenant, October 15, 1752; captain, July 1, 1759. As early as 1743, he appears in various financial transactions connected with the exploitation of the lead mines of Illinois. In 1746, his partnership in Illinois with Declozeau was wound up (Louisiana Historical Quarterly, 14:253; 16:337-338.) His death occurred some time between July and September, 1759 (A N Colonies D2C52:125-125v.)

Death record reads:

Légalisation du certificat de mort de M. de Gruis, capitaine dans les troupes de la Louisiane, décédé aux Illinois le 25 février 1759. Ledit certificat donné par M. de Kerlérec, gouverneur de la Louisiane, le 16 mars 1767.

It seems that the document is a draft copy of the official document. It is nowadays kept in the dossiers of the French colonial staff of Louisiana in the French Archives nationales. (French archivists regret that the French archives kept in Louisiana are almost not exploitable - they are set chronologically - and would be very interesting for rebuilding the history of French period, including the one of the families). Notes for MARIE-THERESE AUFRERE:

The census of the Inhabitants of New Orleans taken in January, 1732, lists the Aufrere household on St. Louis Street. Living with Monsieur Aufrere were his wife and three children. That census reported a total of 626 whites and 267 Negroes living in New Orleans.

Passage from the book "St. Charles Abstracts of the Civil Records of St Charles Parish 1700-1803", Glenn R. Conrad:

INVENTORY OF THE COMMUNITY PROPERTY OF JOSEPH DUSIAU AND HIS LATE WIFE, THERESE AUFRERE (No. 107, 6-30-1774). Upon learning of the death of Therese Aufrere, wife of Joseph Dusiau and widow of DeGruys. Inventory taken in the presence of Dusiau; Jean-Baptiste DeGruy and Joseph DeGruy, children of the decedent by her former marriage.

Partition, Dec. 20, 1772. Joseph Dusiau, seeking to conclude his responsibilities as tutor of the children of DeGruys, renders an account of his tutorship to the DeGruys children, namely: Marie-Therese, Hyancinte, Jean-Baptiste, Joseph, Antoine and Pierre DeGruys.

(No. 194, 1-14-1777) RELEASE. Jean-Baptiste DeGruys, Joseph Verloin DeGruys, Therese DeGruys and Hyacinte DeGruys declare in the presence of ..., that they have released M. Joseph Dusiau, their stepfather and tutor, from his responsibilities as guardian of their inheritance from their father and mother, DeGruys and Therese Aufrere. (Note: all of the DeGruys spelled their surname Degruy.)

She was born November 11, 1780, and died February 13, 1853 in New Orleans, LA²³.

Notes for JEAN-BAPTISTE DEGRUY:

In 1792, Juan Baptista Degrui, previously a 1st Lieteneant in the German Coast

Disciplined Provincial Militia was "breveted" (promoted to) captain of the Militia.

Jean Baptiste was an indigo farmer when not called into military action.

Following is an excerpt from a court case where the sons of Jean Antoine D'Auterive are seeking to regain rights to land of their father:

'The petitioners show, that it appears from said statement that the said Bernard D'Auterive occupied said land as a stockfarm, for which purpose it had been granted, up to the time of his death, which occurred in 1776; that the said D'Auterive left a widow and four small children; that in 1779 his widow married Jean Baptiste Degruy; that the said Degruy and his wife continued to occupy said land as a stockfarm, and to cultivate a small part thereof, until 1784, when they removed to the Mississippi; that thereafter the said land, and even the stock kept thereon, were utterly neglected by said Degruy; that in consequence thereof, and on account of their ignorance of said claim, the Spanish authorities in Louisiana granted a considerable, and the most valuable, part of said land to other persons

The land is described as follows:- A tract of land called the prairie of the Vermilion, bounded on the east by the River (now called Bayou) Tortue and Lake Tasse; at the north by the 'mauvais bois' (low woodland); on the west by the River (now called Bayou) Vermilion; and at the south by a soft prairie. These are all natural, well-known boundaries. Bayou Tortue and Bayou Vermilion are considerable watercourses, and are still known by the same names; so is Lake Tasse. The land granted is a prairie; its northern boundary is the first woodland-a low swamp-to the north of the prairie, and its southern boundary is the soft or salt marsh which skirts the whole sea-shore of Western Louisiana."

JOSEPH FRANCOIS VERLOIN⁴ DEGRUY (*ANTOINE VALENTINE VERLOIN*³, *ANTOINE GASPARD DEGRUY*² VERLOIN, CLAUDE DEGRUY¹) was born March 8, 1752 in Kaskaskia, St Clair County, Illinois Fort de Chartes, and died January 22, 1830 in New Orleans, LA²⁶. He married MARIANNE COUTOURIER Bef. 1787²⁷, daughter of PIERRE COUTOURIER and MARIE-FRANCOISE DUPONT. She was born February 8, 1753 in New Orleans, LA²⁸, and died July 25, 1819 in New Orleans, LA.

Notes for JOSEPH FRANCOIS VERLOIN DEGRUY:

On June 22, 1785, brothers Joseph, Jean Baptiste and Pierre were listed on the "Census of all of the Militiamen Able to Carry Arms of the Parish of St. Charles des Allemands". They each owned land on the right bank of the Mississippi river. There were a total of 29 militiamen living on the right bank and 114 on the left bank of the river. (Living on the left bank were several of the Brou brothers.)

The 1804 General Census of St. Charles Parish provides the following information about Joseph: he owned 18 Arpents of land with 100 bbls of rice, 100 bbls of corn and 200 cords of firewood in production. Living with him were his wife, 2 sons and 2 daughters-in-law. Also living on the property were "1 free Negro (male) &, his daughter, 13 male slaves, 4 female slaves, 1 male mulatto and 1 female mulatto." (From the book St Charles, Abstracts of Civil Records.)

Thomas Antoine Verloin deGruy, son of deGruy & Couturier, is listed on the 1810 census in Plaquemines Parish. In 1814 Jean Victor Baudier appears on a muster roll during the Battle of New Orleans. Baudier would have been not quite 16 years old. Baudier then goes missing for the next ten years. Perhaps Baudier met deGruy during the Battle of

New Orleans and went to work for him on his plantation in Plaquemines Parish. Baudier was attached to Villere's company which was stationed in St Bernard. Both deGruy & Baudier came from families originating in the Champagne region of France and both were descendents of career French officers. In 1824 Baudier marries a Thomas deGruy daughter at St Louis Cathedral. In 1828 and 1830 Baudier's residence was listed on documents as being in Plaquimines Parish.

Since I cannot find Thomas deGruy on the census in Plaquemines Parish after the 1810 census, perhaps he and his family moved elsewhere, leaving his plantation in the care of Baudier. DeGruy did not die until 1822. His wife, Josephine Guerin was living with her daughter and son-in-law in 1850 in New Orleans in the 3rd municipality.

The Baudiers were listed in New Orleans during the 1840 & 1850 censuses, even though I know that they spent the years between the censuses, the 1840s, in St Martin Parish [Attakapas Parish]. In 1860 the Baudiers were back again to Plaquemines Parish, residing at Jesuit Bend. I would think that perhaps the Thomas deGruy family had extensive land holdings in Plaquemines Parish. DeGruy was listed as havng 22 slaves in 1810. Perhaps that was one reason that the Baudier deGruy family kept returning to Plaquemines.
