Orff-Schulwerk FAQ's

Q *What is Orff-Schulwerk?*

A Orff-Schulwerk is an approach to teaching and learning music based on activities children naturally like to do: sing, chant rhymes, clap, dance, and keep a beat on anything near at hand. These instincts are directed into learning music by creating first, then reading and writing it later.

Q *I don't have many instruments. How can Orff-Schulwerk apply to my teaching?*

A Orff-Schulwerk is about more than the barred instruments. If you want your teaching to be more alive, have your students be actively involved, and impress your principal, Orff-Schulwerk is for you!

Saturday, October 18, 2008*

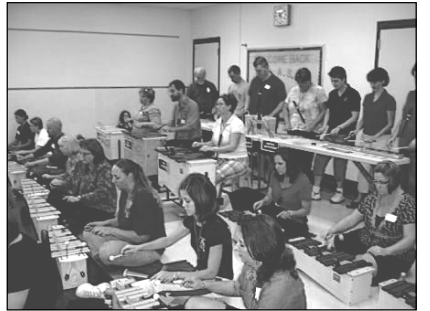
