Attendance Policy, Grading and Rules

As a teacher, grades are one way I can evaluate you, the student. In order for me to give you the best grade you deserve, all you need to do is follow these steps:

1. The student is expected to be in class everyday. If you are absent for any reason you have the responsibility of finding out what you have missed and make up the work.

- Homework, projects, quizzes and tests will be posted and students will be told before they are due. I will not accept any excuse about not knowing what the assignments are.
- If you are absent, the student has the amount of days missed plus one to make up the work.
- Once the student has taken the unit exam, the work from that unit can no longer be made up.
- After the make-up work period time is over or at the end of a unit, which ever comes first, missing scores will become a zero.

2. All late work will be docked points for each day it is late.

- Do not copy work, late or not, from anyone or the textbook. Any assignment that is word for word the same as another student or from the text will result in a zero and a letter will be going home to your parents.

3. Grades will be based on points earned and divided by the total number of possible points. Grades will be based on homework, quizzes, projects, tests, attendance, class participation etc... Grades will be determined on the scale of 90-80-70-60-50...based on the above criteria.

4. Exams will be given at the completion of each unit. Quizzes will be given periodically through the unit. The student will have ample notice of all exams and quizzes along with a study guide.

5. Homework will be given on a daily basis. It will be due the next day or when otherwise specified.

What the Students Need to Know About Math Class
