<u>DESCRIPTION</u>	Scholarships will be awarded to outstanding American high school graduates, or Chinese junior high school graduates or full-time college students. Recipients will be notified in August 2009.
<u>ELIGIBILITY and BASIS OF AWARDS</u>	
1. Grade Levels completed	Applicants must be Chinese junior high or American high school graduates between January and July 2009 or full-time college students who completed their first, second or third year of college.
2. Association Membership	The applicant must have the surname 趙. His/her parent(s) must be a due paying member of the San Francisco Chew Family Association <u>and</u> must have made an annual donation to the Association
3. GPA	Applicant must attain a minimum 3.2 Grade Point Average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale during the current school year.
4. Essay	Submit a 500 word essay on one of the following topics (No duplicates from previous years): 1. What the Chew Family Association Means to Me. 2. My Ambitions and Goals. 3. What the Chinese Language Means to Me. The essay should be typewritten or legibly written.
