Registration

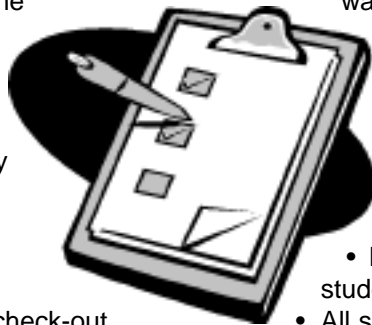
Children must be five years old on or before Sept. 1 to enroll in kindergarten, and six years old on or before Sept. 1 to enroll in first grade. State law requires students to be in school from ages five to 17.

Parents who choose not to send their child to a public or private five-year-old kindergarten must sign a waiver to that effect. Waiver forms are available at all elementary schools.

To register a child for any grade, parents must take the following documents to the school that serves their residence: child's Social Security card, birth certificate, S.C. Immunization Form and two proofs of residence, such as utility bills.

To register a child who is transferring from another school district, parents should take the child's latest report card and the check-out card from the previous school, in addition to the documents required for registration.

The following are recommended for registration, if available: academic record (transcript, report cards, test scores); copy of special education IEP, if applicable; and any other records which will be helpful in placing the student in the appropriate academic program.



year, the student must enroll in the zoned school.

Fees

- There are no general fees in the district.
- Textbooks are provided free of charge to all students, as is access to computers.
- Certain courses require materials fees.
- There are fees for extracurricular activities, such as athletic events, plays and field trips.
- Band and orchestra students must own or rent an instrument. Fees for those may be waived for students who cannot afford them.
- All student athletes and cheerleaders are required to have school accident insurance.
- Out-of-district tuition fees and the application process are handled through the Registrar's Office.
- Fees are charged for transcripts of student records.
- All students must pay for lost and damaged books, materials, supplies and equipment.

The student's report card may be held until these charges are paid. A student is not allowed to participate in graduation exercises if any debt is owed to the school.

Attendance

In South Carolina, all children are required by law to attend a public or private school if they have reached 5 years of age before September 1st until their 17th birthday.

- If a parent chooses not to send his or her child to kindergarten, a waiver must be signed. Waiver forms are available at the school.
- Students are counted present only when they are in school, on homebound instruction, or participating in an approved activity away from school (field trip, music festival, athletic competition, student convention, *etc.*).
- According to school board policy, credit will be denied in high school credit courses (grades 8-12) when a student has more than four absences (excused and/or unexcused, in any combination) in a half-credit course or more than eight absences (excused or unexcused, in any combination) in a credit course unless approved by the school's attendance committee.
- Students who accumulate three consecutive unexcused absences or five cumulative unexcused absences are truant. By law, parents of these students must meet with school officials to develop an Intervention Plan to address the truant behavior or risk being summoned to Family Court. Parents are encouraged to contact their child's school if they have questions regarding their child's attendance. For further information on the district's attendance policy, parents may check the Web site,

www.richlandone.org, or contact the Office of School Social Work at 231-6748.

Code of Conduct

- School rules are designed to protect students and to ensure safe, orderly schools.
- The district's Discipline Code provides parents and students with the district's expectations for student conduct.
- These specific student conduct rules are reviewed annually with all students in all grades.
- Students may be disciplined by school officials for conduct on school property, while engaged in or attending a school activity or while going to or returning home from school.
- Each student receives a copy of the Discipline Code to take home at the beginning of the school year. If the student does not receive a copy, contact the principal. It also is available on the district's Web site, www.richlandone.org. In addition to the Discipline Code, individual schools and teachers have rules that apply to specific situations. Students should know what those rules are and the consequences for violating them.

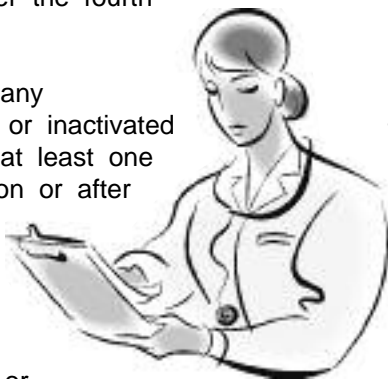


Immunizations

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control has declared the following schedule of required vaccinations, screenings, and immunizations necessary for a child to be admitted to any public, private, or parochial school, grades kindergarten through twelve (K-12), or child development program under the control of the State Department of Education for the 2007-2008 school year.

Minimum Requirements

- Four (4) doses of any combination of DTP, DT, DTP-Hib, DTaP, Td, Tdap vaccine with at least one (1) dose received on or after the fourth birthday.
- Three (3) doses of any combination of oral or inactivated Polio vaccine with at least one (1) dose received on or after the fourth birthday.
- Two (2) doses of Rubeola (Measles) vaccine with both doses received on or after the first birthday and separated by at least one month.
- One (1) dose of Rubella (German Measles) vaccine received on or after the first birthday.
- One (1) dose of Mumps vaccine received on or after the first birthday.
- Three (3) doses of Hepatitis B vaccine.
- One (1) dose of Varicella vaccine received on or after the first birthday or positive history of disease for all children admitted to kindergarten, first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh grades.



School Assignment

Students are assigned to schools based upon where their parents or guardians live. If parents are divorced or legally separated, the student is assigned to the school based upon where the custodial parent lives.

If a student's permanent, home address changes after the first grading period, the student is given the option of remaining at the same school for the school year. This request must be made through the Registrar's Office. At the beginning of the next school

“Busy Bodies” from Lewis Greenview Elementary win first place at Odyssey of the Mind World Finals

Quick thinking, creativity and the ability to thrive under pressure helped Lewis Greenview Elementary students win first place in Division I of the World Finals of the Odyssey of the Mind competition held May 23–26 in East Lansing, Michigan.

The Busy Bodies competed against 65 teams from schools around the nation and the world including Canada, China and South Korea. The competition was held on the campus of Michigan State University. As state Odyssey of the Mind champs, three teams of Lewis Greenview students won the privilege of competing in the World Finals.

The Odyssey of the Mind is an international educational program that provides creative problem-solving opportunities for students from kindergarten to college. The problem presented to the Busy Bodies in the World Finals was in the category called "Classics ...Around the World in 8 Minutes." The team had to create and present a performance that includes a "Traveler" character on a trip around the world.

Being world champions has its perks, privileges and just rewards. On June 6 the Busy Bodies got the VIP treatment at the State House, including a tour, standing ovation from legislators and a framed legislative resolution recognizing their achievement.

As the girls stood to be recognized in the House chambers, the only smiles gleaming brighter than theirs were those of their very proud parents, grandparents, teachers, coaches and principal. Rep. Dennis Moss, D-Cherokee, introduced the fifth-graders and their coaches, John and Sonya Tolbert.

After-school programs offer opportunities for students to improve academic achievement

Richland One offers before- and after-school initiatives designed to increase academic achievement through structured before-school, after-school, weekend and summer programs.

After-School Care

The After-School Child Care Programs are provided through agreements with schools and licensed child-care providers approved by the district. These programs provide a safe place for children to go after school where they can receive services that will enhance their social and educational growth and development. These programs operate Monday through Friday, from 2:30 p.m. until 6 p.m. and are located at all of the district's 28 elementary schools, and one middle school (Southeast Middle School). A weekly fee is charged to parents for these services.

Athletic Tutorial

Athletic Tutorial Programs are located at each middle and high school across Richland County School District One. Athletic Tutorial Programs are open to all students. However, these programs are mandatory for students participating in competitive co-curricular activities and who are in danger of falling below the 2.0 grade-point average required by the district for athletic team participation. The students/student athletes must attend at least three times a week for a minimum of 2 hours each session.

Comprehensive Remediation (CRP Scholars Program)

Comprehensive Remediation programs are offered at each of the 28 elementary and nine middle schools in the district. The program operates three days a week for two hours a day and is designed to increase students' achievement on district benchmark tests and state assessments by providing individual instruction. This program also focuses on students' skill deficiencies on the Palmetto Achievement Challenge Test.

John and James Knight Foundation

The Richland One Arts-Infused Program focuses on developing, enhancing and reinforcing the knowledge and skills required to prepare middle-

school students for a meaningful future. This program's benchmarks include: widening students' knowledge of city cultural and artistic resources and institutions, enhancing students' attendance rates, and strengthening students' engagement in school. It serves Sanders Middle School and Gibbes Middle School and operates Tuesday and Thursday, 4 p.m.-6 p.m. This arts-infused (on-site and off-site) program is funded by a grant from the John S. and James L. Knight Foundation. The four community partners/service providers include: Riverbanks Zoo, Trustus Theater, the Columbia Museum of Art, and EdVenture Children's Museum.

PRIORITIES 21st Century Community Learning Centers Program

This program is funded through a four-year grant from the S.C. Department of Education. The program is designed to improve the academic achievement of students at Burton-Pack, Burnside and E.E. Taylor Elementary Schools. It operates five days a week for three hours per day and provides students and parents with a variety of services to improve their quality of life. Additionally, the program offers artistic, cultural enrichment opportunities for students and their families when school is not in session.

Project ACT

Project ACT (Active by Choice Today) After School Program is sponsored by the Department of Psychology and Arnold School of Public Health – University of South Carolina. Project ACT is a youth obesity prevention program. The mission of Project ACT is to promote healthy behaviors in sixth graders in South Carolina, emphasize being good role models and citizens, and provide homework completion time and assistance. Project ACT is a large national Institute of Health-funded research study that will be held in 24 middle schools nationally over the next three years. The project serves approximately 2,000 underserved children. Project ACT runs for 13 weeks at St. Andrews Middle School and Crayton Middle School.

What Is Odyssey of the Mind?

Odyssey of the Mind is an international educational program that provides creative problem solving opportunities for students from kindergarten through college. Students apply their creativity to solve problems that range from building mechanical devices to presenting their own interpretation of literary classics. They then bring their solutions to competitions on the local, state, and world levels. Thousands of teams from throughout the U.S. and from about 25 other countries participate in the program.

Extended Day Programs:

Academic Core

The academic core consists of reading, mathematics, social studies and science. The program provides one-on-one college and adult tutors and homework assistance, according to the needs of the students. Students work on developing academic skills in computer labs and use the Internet to access the resources for school assignments and projects. At each school site, teachers provide direct instruction and work with collaborating community partners on tutoring, instructional strategies and homework assistance.

Enrichment Core

The enrichment core is designed to provide students with a variety of activities including, but not limited to music, drama, physical activities, motivational speakers, crafts, the performing arts and dance. The arts offer an alternative for success to students who struggle academically. Involvement in the arts also helps students understand the importance of hard work, self-discipline and commitment to excellence.

Intervention Core

The intervention core is designed to provide students with best-practices and strategies to divert them from risky behaviors. Extended Day Programs assist the district and community with keeping students safe during the after-school hours, providing quality child-care to assist working parents/families, curbing youth violence, enhancing the health and well-being of students, reducing/preventing youth crime, reducing risky behaviors, offering academic remediation and academic assistance, impacting teen pregnancy prevention, influencing truancy and drop-out prevention, impacting character and leadership development, and establishing vital community partnerships as a means of intervention to engage students in meaningful, positive activities. Students who are experiencing social, academic, or personal development issues are identified and referred to the Office of Extended Day Program.

Volunteering

PARTNER • MENTOR • TUTOR

Volunteers provide thousands of hours of service to Richland One youth

Each year, more than 2,500 parents, business partners and community members volunteer in one of our 50 schools and programs. In 2006-2007, volunteers provided more than 150,000 hours of service.

The purpose of the Richland One Volunteer Program is to establish nurturing relationships between students and adults to enhance students' self-concept, decrease discipline referrals, reduce absenteeism and to motivate students to improve their academic performance. It also serves to build a constituency for public education and child advocacy.

Persons interested in volunteering should complete a volunteer application available in all Richland One schools or on the volunteer Web page of the Richland One Web site. Richland One conducts and incurs all costs of the criminal, child abuse and neglect and sex offender background checks. Please allow 2-4 weeks for volunteer application processing.

During the 2007-2008 school year, Richland One is deploying the V-Soft Raptor visitor tracking system (commonly known as Raptor or V-Soft). The overall goal of this system is to better control access to all Richland One schools, thus providing enhanced protection for our students and staff. Some of the features of the program include the production of visitor/volunteer badges, tracking volunteer hours and electronically checking all visitors against registered sexual offender databases.

There are a variety of volunteer opportunities to select from:

- Mentors help a student to broaden his/her vision of opportunities, understand the value of education and accomplish academic and personal goals. Volunteers must commit to one hour a week for one school year for this school-based mentoring program.
- Lunch Buddies (typically work place groups of 15 or more) are volunteers that are matched one-on-one with a student to share lunch, fun and friendship twice a month throughout the school year.
- Tutors work (under the direction of a teacher) with students one-on-one or in small groups who need additional academic support. Tutors typically commit between two and four hours a month throughout the school year.
- Partnerships include businesses, faith organizations, civic organizations and institutions of higher learning working in partnership with schools to help improve academic achievement.
- Classroom Volunteers provide support to the classroom teacher and work under his/her supervision to reinforce the basic skills with individual students or small groups. Classroom volunteers may read with students, work with arts, crafts or music classes, participate in physical education activities or assist in the media center.
- School Support Volunteers give support for non-instructional programs and activities. School support volunteers may chaperone field trips, provide clerical support, serve on a committee, and work with special projects.

Numerous programs help special students to succeed

Students (ages 3 through 21) who are referred, evaluated and identified as children with disabilities and determined to need special education, are served in the least restrictive environment.

Decisions are made by a team of educators and parents. Services are based upon individual student needs. Federal and state guidelines require that students with disabilities participate with non-disabled students to the maximum extent appropriate to meet the needs of each student. In an effort to meet the needs of students identified as having disabilities, Richland School District One has a full continuum of special education programs. "Continuum of services" refers to a range of placement options including service by an itinerant special education teacher or speech therapist for less than five hours per week, by a special education resource teacher for less than half the day, in a setting co-taught by a general education and a special education teacher, in a special education self-contained class for more than half the day, or in a special school.

The following disabilities are served by Special Education in Richland One:

- Autism
- Emotional Disability
- Mental Disability
- Hearing Impairment
- Learning Disability
- Orthopedic Impairment
- Other Health Impairment
- Preschool Children with Disabilities
- Speech and Language Impairment
- Traumatic Brain Injury
- Visual Impairment

Pendergrass Fairwold

Pendergrass Fairwold School serves students ages 3-21 functioning within the range of moderate to severe cognitive mental abilities. The school provides a program for students who are medically fragile or whose multiple disabilities require a total environment especially designed to meet their unique needs. Enrollment is through the recommendation of a multidisciplinary committee and the student's IEP.

The school also offers a community-based, functional skills curriculum for students who require a total environment designed to meet their special education needs. Emphasis is placed upon transitional skills for success at home, in the community and into the workforce.

District outlines steps taken in the event of severe weather

When a decision is made to close Richland One schools, officials take great care to ensure the safety of students and to notify parents and the public as quickly as possible.

The most important thing that students and parents can do is to **NOT** call schools, administrative offices, the weather bureau or radio and TV stations for this information. This needlessly ties up telephone lines and can hinder district officials as they attempt to notify the public. All pertinent information will be provided to TV and radio stations once a decision is made.

- Decisions to close schools or delay school openings are made on a daily basis when there is inclement weather and usually are made no later than 6:30 a.m. each morning (or the night before, if possible). All schools follow the same procedures concerning inclement weather conditions.
- Decisions for early dismissal of schools during the school day because of weather conditions are made early enough to allow parents adequate time to pick up students. Adults supervise students until school buses leave for home or parents pick up students.
- Other school emergencies may result in closing, delayed opening or early dismissal of schools.
- Local radio and TV stations carry announcements about school closings as soon as such decisions are made. This information is posted on the district's home page, www.richlandone.org and is carried on Richland One TV, as well as the district's InfoPhone at 231-7512.
- Parents are encouraged to discuss plans for early dismissal with their children during the first weeks of school.

Healthy and Nutritious School Environment policy

Federal law required all school districts participating in the National School Lunch Program to have a wellness policy in place by July 1, 2006. The wellness policy, at a minimum, should include guidelines for all elementary students regarding all foods available to students at school, goals for nutrition education, and goals for physical activity and physical education. While the requirements are limited to grades K-5, Richland One has adopted the same requirements for all grade levels.

In short the policy includes:

Nutrition Guidelines:

- Access to Food - All schools will make the return of meal applications a high priority.
- Food Safety and Sanitation - Annually SNS will train all food service employees and canteen managers.
- Quality Food
 - All foods and beverages available to students during the school day in all venues, must meet district nutrition standards for nutrients and portion sizes.
 - Food should not be used as punishment/reward or as a learning incentive in the classroom
 - Schools must appropriately plan schedules to allow students adequate time to eat. The law requires 20 minutes after the student has been served.
 - SNS and school administrators will work together to monitor policy compliance.

Nutrition Education:

- Nutrition Education Weekly K-5
- Comprehensive Health Education Compliance Report
- Professional Development – nutrition, physical activity & academic achievement

Physical Education and Activity (K-5)

- Beginning 2006-07 – 60 minutes of physical education & 90 minutes of physical activity weekly
- Beginning 2008-09 – 90 minutes of physical education & 60 minutes of physical activity weekly
- Physical Activity Coordinator to coordinate physical activity initiatives

All Schools:

- Health Related Fitness Report to Parents
- South Carolina Physical Education Assessment every 3 years (results reported on the school & district report cards)
- Withholding participation in recess/physical activity for discipline reasons is strongly discouraged

Richland One offers many challenging learning opportunities for academically talented students

The Advanced Academic Program (AAP) in Richland One provides a rigorous, accelerated, and enriched course of study for academically talented students who need challenges beyond those provided by the regular school program.

The AAP serves students in grades three through twelve. AAP subjects are as follows:

- AAP reading and language arts in grades 3 – 12
- AAP mathematics in grades 3 – 12
- AAP science in grades 6 – 12
- AAP social studies in grades 6 – 12

Richland One students qualify for the Advanced Academic Program according to either state or local gifted and talented guidelines. Selection methods include an analysis of achievement test scores, aptitude test scores, performance-based tasks and other relevant information.

AAP programs, in addition to honors courses, include Mathematics Education for Gifted Secondary School Students (MEGSSS) for

academically advanced math students in middle and high school and the Advanced Placement (AP) Program, which provides an opportunity for students to acquire college credit for high school course work.

Students in AAP who qualify earn recognition as Middle School Scholars, High School Scholars, South Carolina Junior Scholars, and Duke Talent Identification Program (TIP) honorees.

Academic All-Stars

Although not a part of AAP, Richland One's Academic All-Star Banquet recognizes outstanding senior scholars at the district's seven high schools. To qualify as Academic All-Stars, students must be ranked in the top 10 percent of their high school's senior class and have at least a 3.5 grade-point average. They also must have no grade lower than a C for any subject completed for high-school credit.

District issues a Parents Guide to Understanding School Attendance

Who must attend school?

Richland One expects each student to attend school daily for the entire period of every school day except in cases of illness, family emergency or other reasons specifically stated in this rule. A student who fails to attend school and has accrued three consecutive unlawful absences or a total of five unlawful absences is truant. Such a student is in violation of state law.



What happens if a student is late to school or class?

Students who are late are marked tardy. Each school has a tardy policy that determines the consequences for students being late to class.

What is the procedure that should be followed after an absence?

Students who have been absent must provide a written notice from the parent/guardians to the school explaining the reason for the absence within two school days after the student returns. The principal will determine whether the absence is excused or unexcused. In all cases of lawful excused absences, the student will be given an opportunity to make up the school work missed.

What happens if notification regarding the absence is not provided to the school?

The student's absence will be considered unexcused.

What is the limitation of absences?

The limitation of absences is three consecutive unlawful absences or a total of five unlawful absences.

What are the consequences for exceeding the limitation of absences?

A school administrator will contact the parent/guardian. The parent/guardian should be instructed to schedule an appointment to meet with the attendance committee chairperson to complete an Attendance Intervention Plan (AIP). If the parent/guardian does not respond, it is permissible for the school to send the AIP by certified mail. Should the parent/guardian refuse to cooperate with and the student accumulates two additional unexcused absences, a petition may be filed. A petition may also be filed should the parent/guardian develop an AIP and fail to comply with the plan and the child continues to accrue unexcused absences. In either situation the child is deemed a "habitual truant."

What are the consequences for being cited as a habitual truant?

This child may need court intervention and an initial truancy petition may be filed. The written intervention plan, and documentation of noncompliance, must be attached to the truancy petition asking for court intervention.

When attendance problems arise, is assistance available to students and parents?

Each school must utilize its attendance committee or convene the school's Student Intervention Team on a regular basis to address issues of student attendance. The attendance committee should meet a minimum of once per month to discuss the school's progress on meeting the established attendance goals.

International Welcome Center

Because the number of culturally and linguistically diverse students in Richland One has increased steadily over the last several years, the district established a center to welcome new families and to ease their transition into the community. Currently, students represent 41 countries and as many languages.

The International Welcome Center opened in August 2004 and is located at A.C. Moore Elementary School, 333 Etiwan Ave., Columbia, SC 29205. It serves as a one-stop-shop for new international families. Students take language proficiency tests at the center while their parents complete enrollment documents and gain information about the district's English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) program and services available to their students. At the end of this initial visit, children are referred to the school that best meets their needs.

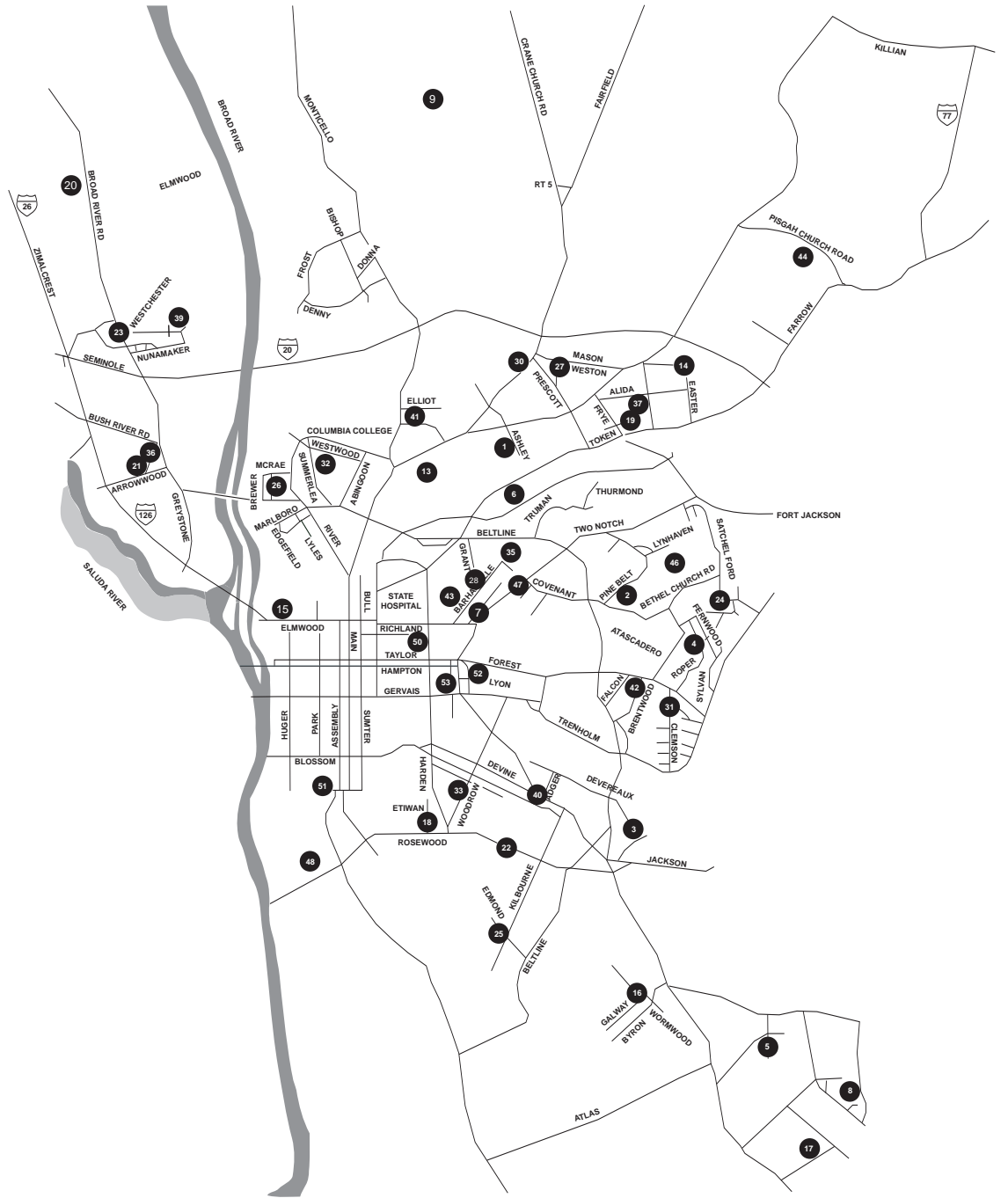

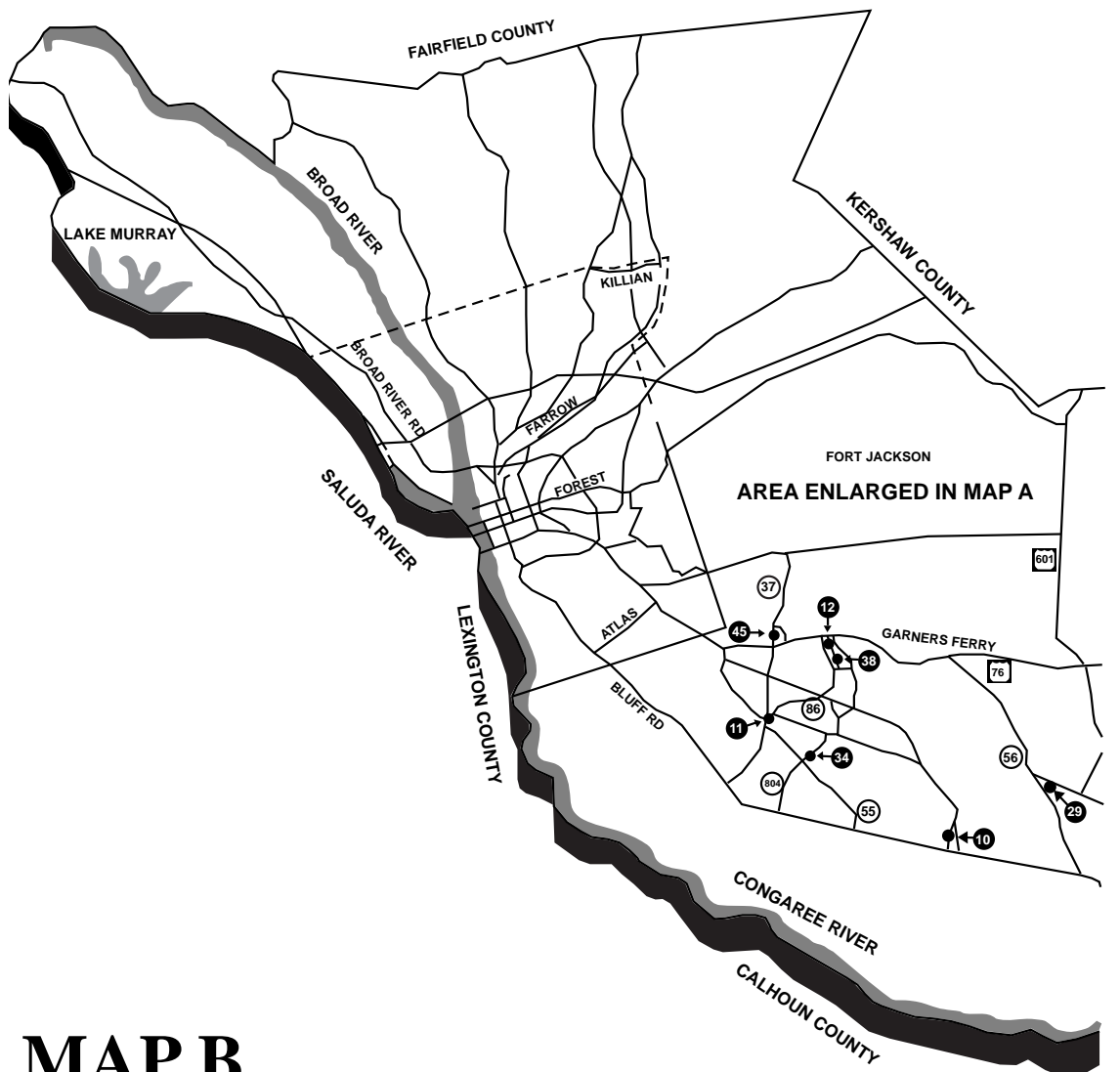

Richland One Transportation lists important items for riding buses

Unless specified in a student's IEP, buses are routed to provide pick-up and drop-off services at designated bus stops. Because bus arrival times are often influenced by many factors such as traffic flow, operational delays, weather conditions etc., bus schedules arrival times are estimates.

Students should arrive at their designated bus stop at least five minutes before the scheduled pick-up time. Parents and students should note and remember their bus number and driver's name. Please post this information in your home. Bus schedules are subject to change throughout the year as bus stops and the numbers of students are added, deleted or adjusted. Parents/students and schools will be advised of these changes.

Students eligible for door-to-door services must have a parent or guardian available during the pick-up to assist in the loading of their child and available to receive their child on the return trip. When no one is home to receive the child, the student will be returned to the school and the school will contact the parent to pick up the student. Repeated instances of not being available to receive a child may result in notification to local law enforcement or the Richland County Department of Social Services.

While aboard the bus, the bus driver is the designated school official responsible for the safety and accountability of the students. Students must comply with the instructions provided by the driver. In instances of student misbehavior aboard the school bus, Transportation officials will notify the appropriate school administrator. In accordance with the Richland One Discipline Code, specific acts of misbehavior may result in the student's suspension from school or the school bus or a recommendation from the principal for expulsion. We solicit parents' help in discussing school bus safety rules and the content of the Discipline Code with their children.

Parent and Guardian Responsibility

On July 1, 2000, a proviso in the state Appropriations Act for fiscal year 2001 affirmed parental or guardian responsibility for the safety and conduct of children traveling between their home and school bus stop.

Parents or guardians of a child being transported on a school bus are responsible for the safety and conduct of the child prior to the arrival of the school bus at the child's designated school bus stop for pick-up and transport to school, and after the school bus drops off the child and departs the child's designated school bus stop when transporting the children from school.

District transportation officials strongly encourage parental and adult supervision of students while they are waiting or returning to their designated bus stop.

Alternate Pick-Up/ Drop-Off Locations

Under the provisions of Jacob's Law, students/parents requesting an alternate pick-up/drop-off location must forward a written request directly to the principal or the local STS office. Requests must include the student's name, parent/guardian's name, home address, alternate address and telephone numbers. To be considered (1) students must be eligible for transportation and (2) the alternate address must be within the school's attendance zone. The local STS office will review the request with a written response forwarded back to the requesting party and copy to the attending school.

Students may be dropped off on a space available basis at an alternate location when the parent or school administrator provides proper authorization.

Request for alternate pick-up/drop-off locations must be submitted at the conclusion of any given school year for route planning for the upcoming year. For alternate pick-up/drop-off location requests received after August 1, school bus transportation will start by August 28, 2007.

Transportation Eligibility

It is the district's policy to provide transportation for students who reside a distance of one and one half (1.5) miles or more from the school to which they are zoned. In certain cases, transportation may be authorized for students who live within a 1.5-mile radius. Authorization for this service must be properly requested and approved.

District public school pupils eligible for transportation include three-year-old to five-year-old pupils that are disabled, four-year-old pupils enrolled in a district-sponsored child development program and K-12 students enrolled for the 180-day school year. Students enrolled in special programs operated and sponsored by the district may be authorized school bus transportation when funds and resources are available.

In accordance with federal law, the district will also provide transportation to homeless students to and from their school or origin; students transferring from a Title I school identified for school improvement; students who are victims of violent criminal offenses occurring in or on the ground of the school the student attends; or students authorized to transfer from a school identified as persistently dangerous for three consecutive years. Students enrolled as administrative transfers are not authorized school bus transportation.

Transportation Assistance

The district's transportation services are managed as a centralized operation through two Transportation Area Support Offices. Each Transportation Office is designated to support and work in conjunction with a cluster of area schools. If parents or students require transportation assistance or have questions relating to transportation matters, they may contact their Transportation Area Support Office or their designated school official using the contact information listed on page 15.
