New Business:

The assembly discussed creating citations for groups involved in cemetery maintenance. The commander appointed a committee to investigate clean-up issues at the Garden cemetery in Chelsea and the Wyoming cemetery in Melrose. Committee will consist of CC Burns, Sec. Tucker & PI Bates.

The Camp then voted to endorse Bill Ryerson for National Council.

The finances for Dept. Delegates were discussed, with Sec. Kevin Tucker notifying the Camp as to travel arrangements thus far.

Sec. Tucker reported that he had received permission from the CinC to produce SUV CW bumper stickers for sale, with the proceeds going toward grave marker replacement.

Sec. Tucker reported that he was ready to order the Color Printer for the Dept., as budgeted at the Dept. Encampment.

DC Bates announced that Frank Tucker is appointed Chairman of the 2005 Dept. Encampment. Among the items noted by Br. Tucker were discussion about changing from a Dept. breakfast to a luncheon, where awards would be given, and a set budget committee meeting.
