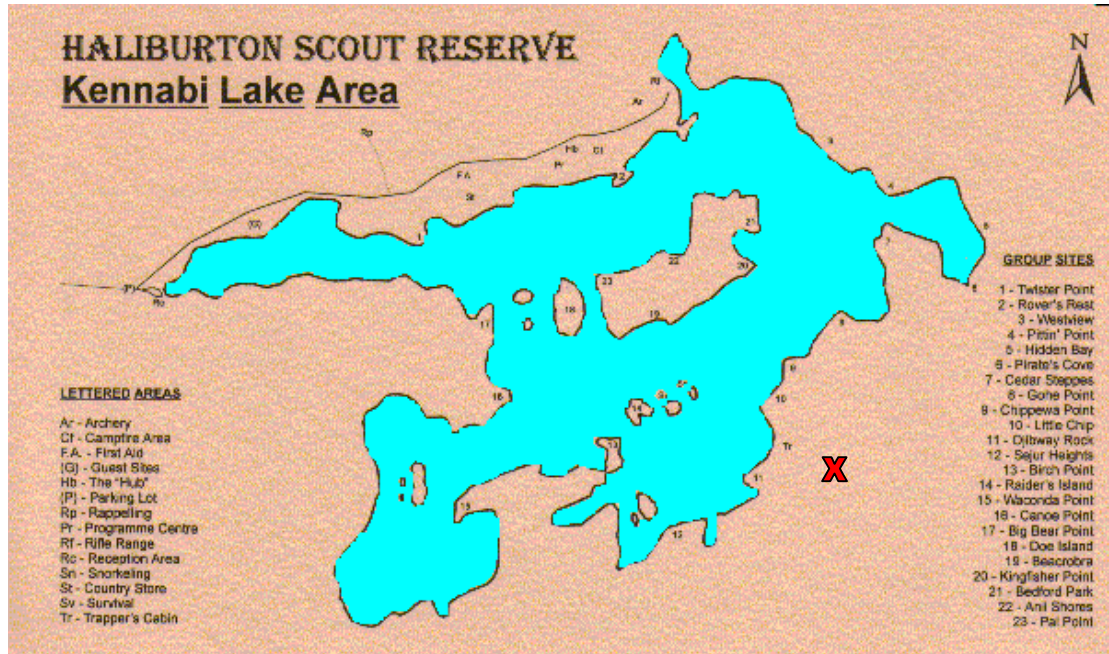




1st Clarence Scouts Haliburton Scout Reserve

Saturday July 31 – August 07, 2004
Cost \$ 250.00* per youth



[Haliburton Scout Reserve](#) is located northeast of the Town of Haliburton on Lake Kennabi. It is approximately a 5 hr drive in light to moderate traffic. We are staying at the **Little Chip Campsite** (noted by the red "X") that is approximately a **2.5 km** paddle from the main activity center. Your youth will spend the week paddling a canoe to attend any of the following activities:

- Kayaking
- Sailing
- Swimming
- Fishing (your youth must bring own gear with no barb hooks)
- Rappelling
- Survival Island
- Snorkel Island
- Trapper's Cabin
- Rifle Range
- Archery Range
- Star Hike
- Pike's Peak Hike
- Wall Climb
- The Camp has badge trading on Tuesday afternoon. If your youth have any badges they wish to trade, please ensure he brings them with him.
- HSR holds a water regatta on Thursday.
- The Camp also holds a Campfire on Friday night for all Campers. Our camp participants are required to perform Songs, Skits, and Cheers, so come prepared.

* Price per youth is subject to increase if fundraising goals are not reached.

There are 22 campsites and the Camp is extremely popular on the international level. It is booked 2 years in advance, so this will be a great opportunity for your youth to meet Scouts from all over the world.

Haliburton Camp has a medical facility on site with both a Doctor and nurse. Scouter Cherilyn and Scouter Francis hold a current in St. John Standard First Aid + CPR Level "C". We have an extensive Area First Aid kit as well as a portable first aid kit when we are away from our campsite. Every person attending this camp **must have a whistle** (Fox 40 preferred) that they are required to wear on their PFD/Lifejacket.

Total cost is \$250.00; we would like two Post-Dated Cheques for \$125 each. The first dated for June 16, 2004 and the second dated for July 21, 2004. Please let us know if there are any financial issues. Cheques are to be made payable to: **Scouts Canada 1st Clarence Scout Group.**

To attend the Camp your Youth is required to complete the following prerequisites:

1. Weekly canoeing sessions
2. Pool Canoe session
3. Day Canoe trip

Attendance at the above mentioned sessions/camp is for the safety of the scouts.

If your youth needs to return home for any reason, a parent, legal guardian, or the designated contact person on your youth's medical form will need to come and pick him up.

Please arrive at HSR by 13:00 with full gear, (see Equipment List).

HSR has a general store where your youth may purchase candy, scouting equipment, and HSR clothing. Please do not give your youth more than \$100 to spend. If your youth purchases junk food they will be required to eat/drink it at the store as they are not allowed to bring it back to the campsite. We will have a variety of healthy main meals and desserts so there should be little need for junk food.

Your youth is required to bring their Ontario Health card with them. If emergency medical treatment is needed the card is required.
