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
President's Corner

What Is CAP?

The Chicago Alumnae Panhellenic (CAP) is one of the most well represented alumnae panhellenics in the Midwest region. CAP was established in June 2001 and chartered by the National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) in May 2002. The purpose of the Chicago Alumnae Panhellenic is:

- 1. To inform collegiate women about the 26 NPC organizations and NPC's membership process.
- 2. To provide a networking system for alumnae women in the Chicago area.
- 3. To provide scholarships for deserving collegiate women from Illinois or women attending a college in Illinois

Structure, Meetings and Events

- 1. Chicago Alumnae Panhellenic council: One delegate and one alternate delegate representing each of the 26 NPC organizations.
- 2. CAP Business meetings: Periodic business meetings for the council members to discuss upcoming activities and important business matters
- 3. Social events: Monthly social event **that is open to all sorority women**. Delegates are encouraged to facilitate information on upcoming CAP events to their members.

Since its creation, Chicago Alumnae Panhellenic has established a presence in the downtown Chicago area. Currently, CAP's main focuses are social, networking and alumnae chapter support events. Philanthropy, programming, and pre-recruitment activities will be included in the near future.

\$500 SCHOLARSHIP offered by Chicago Alumnae Panhellenic, Chicago, Illinois

The Chicago Alumnae Panhellenic Association is offering a non-restrictive \$500 scholarship for the 2008 academic year to sorority women in need of financial assistance. Each applicant must matriculate and remain in their NPC chapter throughout the 2007-2008 academic year.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1. For Greek women attending a higher education institution college/university in Illinois <u>or</u> Greek women who are graduates of an Illinois high school attending a higher education institution college/university outside of Illinois.
- 2. Is a freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior requiring a fifth year for completion of her major attending an accredited 4-year college/university.
- 3. Be an initiated member in good standing of a National Panhellenic Conference.
- 4. Have a grade point average sufficient of 3.2 or higher.
- 5. Demonstrate financial need.
- 6. Demonstrate on-going involvement in her sorority.

HOW TO APPLY/CHECKLIST

- 1. Obtain application materials from the Chicago Alumnae Panhellenic Web Site, www.chicagopanhellenic.org
- 2. Complete the forms thoroughly and ensure <u>all</u> items are received on time. We cannot accept late or incomplete applications.
- 3. Return the Three (3) page Application and an Official College/University Transcript to:

4. Make sure your materials are **postmarked no later than MARCH 1, 2008.**
