



PLEASE SUPPORT THE LITTLE ROCK 26

On Monday, October 29, protestors from across the world joined hands in Little Rock, AR to protest the investment of Stephens Inc. in Huntindon Life Sciences (HLS). At this protest, many people were attacked by police wielding pepper spray, rubber bullets, tear gas, concussion grenades, and stun guns. 26 people were arrested on a variety of misdemeanor charges. Of those 26, 20 were jailed again following a court hearing this morning in which their judge unlawfully demanded that protestors pay for the salaries of those police officers who worked overtime during the event. When everyone refused to plead guilty and pay the fines, the judge set a \$3000 bail for each person and had them immediately taken into custody. Many of these protestors are still in jail at this time.
