

The SCOUTMASTER OF THE YEAR and CUBMASTER OF THE YEAR awards are presented to the Cubmaster and Scoutmaster who has distinguished himself/herself in the performance of his/her job.

The criteria for nominating someone for one of these awards are:

- ◆ The nominee must be registered as either a Cubmaster or Scoutmaster in Chicora District, Pee Dee Area Council, BSA. Others holding positions may qualify for the Scouter of the Year award.
- ◆ The nominee should have completed the basic training course for his/her program area.
- ◆ The Unit served should qualify as a Quality Unit according to the criteria set down by the National Council of the BSA.

Other criteria you should take into consideration although they are not requirements:

- ◆ The unit served should have had a net growth in membership over the previous year's enrollment.
- ◆ The pack or troop served should have an active advancement program with at least 50% of the registered boys advancing at least one rank during the previous year.
- ◆ A Cub Scout Pack should have at least one den representing each age group (Tiger, Wolf, Bear, Webelos).
- ◆ A Scout Troop should have at least 10 days and nights of camping and a long-term summer camp experience during the previous year.

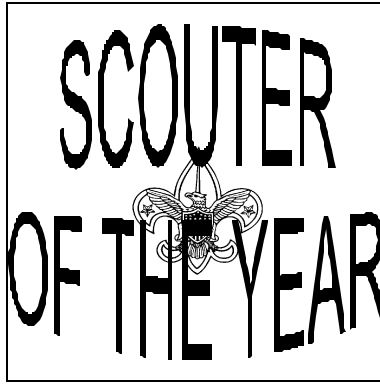

The SCOUTER OF THE YEAR award is presented to a Cub Scout Leader other than a Cubmaster or a Boy Scout Leader other than a Scoutmaster who has distinguished himself/herself in the performance of his/her job.

The criteria for nominating someone for one of these awards are:

- ◆ The nominee must be registered as an adult leader in the Chicora District, Pee Dee Area Council, BSA but may not hold the position of Cubmaster or Scoutmaster
- ◆ The nominee should have completed the basic training course for his/her program area.

Other criteria you should take into consideration although they are not requirements:

- ◆ The nominee should have taken an active role in helping to recruit boys into Scouting during the previous year.
- ◆ The nominee should have taken an active role in encouraging/promoting advancement in the Scouting program during the previous year.
- ◆ The nominee should have promoted the outdoor program of the BSA through support of the Cub Day Camp, Webelos Adventure Camp, and Boy Scout Summer Camp programs as well as weekend camping events for Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts.
