If you have a person **limit your research to their role in World War II!!!** Your paper should only be about two pages typed (approximately 600 words 12 point font- double spaced). I will also require three sources (one of which may be your book, and only one may be internet). You will also create a poster of your person and event, which should be creative and informative about the person/event/concept. Your poster will serve as a part of a WWII museum we will create, in which other students will analyze your work.
