Hyperacidity- excessive acidity, especially in the stomach

Hyperactive- excessively active

Hypercritical- excessively active

Hypersensitive- abnormally sensitive

Hypertension- abnormally high blood pressure

Hypodermic- small syringe with a hollow needle for making injections beneath the skin

Hypoglycemic- afflicted with hypoglycemia- an abnormally low concentration of sugar in the blood

Hyposensitize- make less sensitive

Hypotension- abnormally low blood pressure

Hypothermia- subnormal body temperature

Subaqueous- underwater

Subcutaneous- being, living, or introduced beneath the skin

Sublethal- not quite lethal; insufficient to cause death

Submarginal- below minimum standards; inadequate for some end; unproductive

Subservient- useful in and 'under' or subordinate capacity; excessively submissive.

Supererogatory- beyond the requirements of duty; performed to an extent not demanded

Superficial- over or on the surface only; not profound or thorough

Supernatural- beyond what is natural or observable; not explainable by the laws of nature

Supernumerary- exceeding the standard or prescribed number; extra

Supersonic- having a speed beyond that of sound
