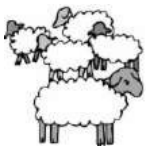


Herding Fun Day!

Have you always wondered what your Belgian Tervuren would do if they were exposed to sheep? Now is your chance to find out! Introduce your Belgian to sheep in a controlled manner and learn some general information about what our dogs were bred for!

A great opportunity for an introduction to sheep herding for you and your dog or to continue on with what you have learned!

*No dogs under the age of 4 months please and Belgian Tervuren Only.

**All dogs must be on lead or crated when not working and barking must be controlled.

What to Bring: Flat Buckled Collar, Water, Shade, Chair, Poop Bags, Your Dog! ☺

Directions:

Rte 495 North or South. Take exit 15, Rte 1A North (away from the Wrentham Outlet Malls). Travel down 1A, until intersection with Rte 121 at light. Bear to right to stay on 1A at this light. Travel approximately ¼ mile and look for balloons on chain link fence on right. This marks the driveway to the farm (set back into woods). Take a right into the driveway after fence/balloons and follow it into woods (turns into gravel) until you turn the corner and see the fields. This is a private property so please be considerate and keep speeds down.
