Over the last few months, I knocked on your door to give you a feedback card concerning the work I am doing as a Community Chaplain in the area, but unfortunately you were not home when I came!

To help you in filling out the card, allow me to take this opportunity to give you a clear outline of just what it is that I have been trying to do in these last years here in East Preston / Reservoir.

BUILDING A GENUINE CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY

To put it simply, everything I have been doing as a Community Chaplain has come under the banner of "Building a Genuine Christian Community". Allow me to explain a little.

You see, in our world, where personal gain and the mighty dollar seem to govern the affairs of many, it takes courage to want to get back to living the way God originally intended: loving God, loving our neighbours, loving sacrificially & with mercy.

But it takes more than courage. We need God's help. Each one of us is naturally trapped in the sins of greed, self-interest, pride, and lack of faith in God. How can we be free to live as God wants us to?

Well, the Bible tells us that long ago God had said to Abraham:

"I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you"
(Genesis 12:2-3).

The result of this blessing was to be 'shalom', a peace and freedom which

would permeate every aspect of life. To fulfil this blessing, God finally sent His Son Jesus to inaugurate the Kingdom of God and to be the world's Saviour and Lord. Jesus announced His mission with these words:

"The Spirit of the Lord is on me because He has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour" (Luke 4:18-19).

The mission of Jesus was to set people FREE: free from oppressive powers and structures, and free from bondage to their sins, so that they could live in love and the fullness of life which God had always intended for people. This is what Christians call the Gospel!

Because Jesus was 100% faithful to God in His life, because He died on the cross for our sins, because He rose again from the dead, and because He gives the Holy Spirit to all who turn from their sins and believe in Him, everyone who follows Jesus can be free to live the life God wants them to live. Hallelujah!!



Today, God is still growing communities of people who will experience the promises and blessings He gave to Abraham, and

He is wanting to build a Christian community right here in East Preston / Reservoir!

And in December 2000, God gave me a dream in which He sent me precisely

to this area to be His servant in helping to build a genuine Christian Community.

To date, over 44 people have opened up their lives to Jesus Christ and become His followers! Around 10 adults and 15 children from our area come regularly to the monthly church services we have been holding in the Preston North East Primary School hall. Approximately 25% of all children at PNE Primary are involved in the Christian Religious Education program (RI). And some local teenagers are part of the fantastic youth group run by the Reservoir Salvation Army at "Shop 16" in Summerhill Village.

All these things and more are evidence to me that people in our area are discovering the abundant life that God wants us to have as we follow Jesus!

I encourage you to keep on "trusting in God with all your heart", or to at least begin doing so! There is no greater decision you can make in life!

I look forward to receiving your filled in feedback card soon!

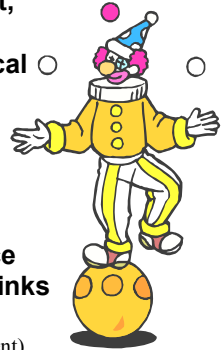
