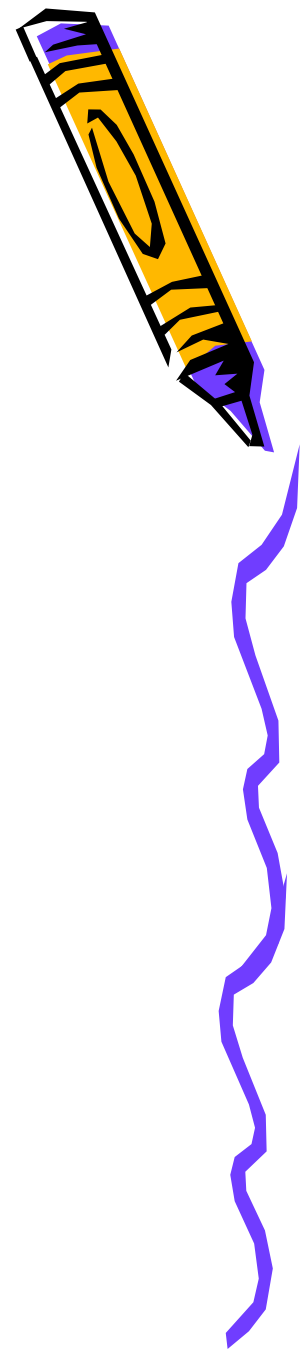

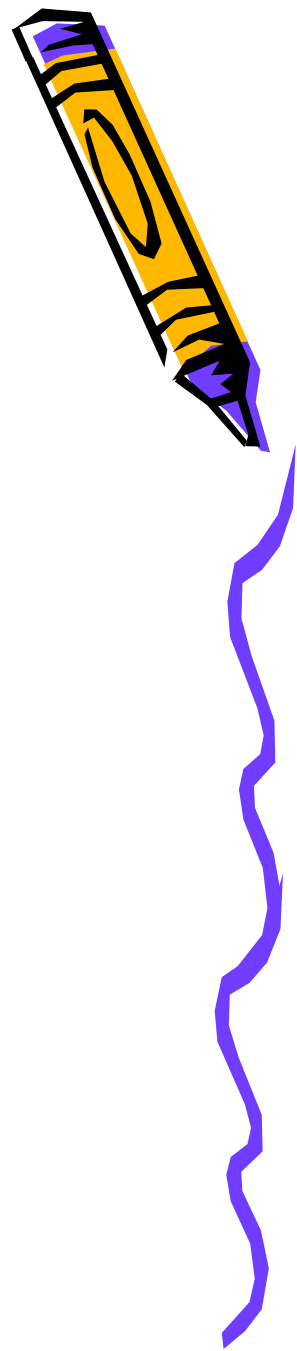


Grandfather Clock helps us count the time, and we talk about the calendar and weather every day!



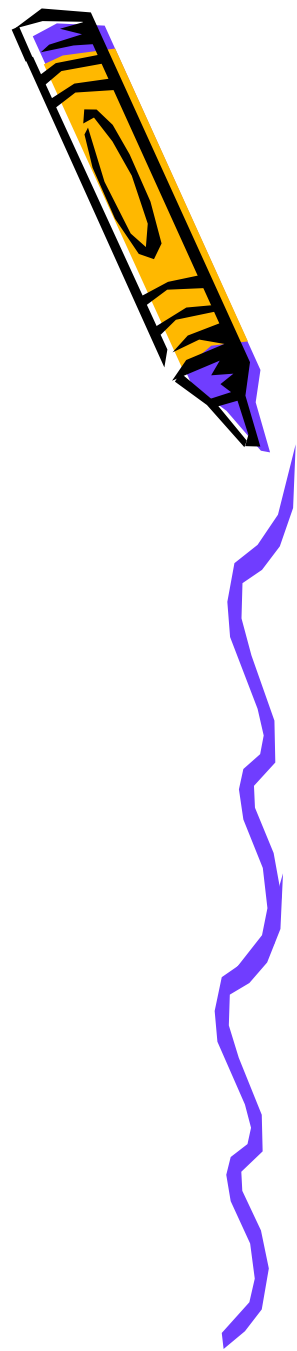


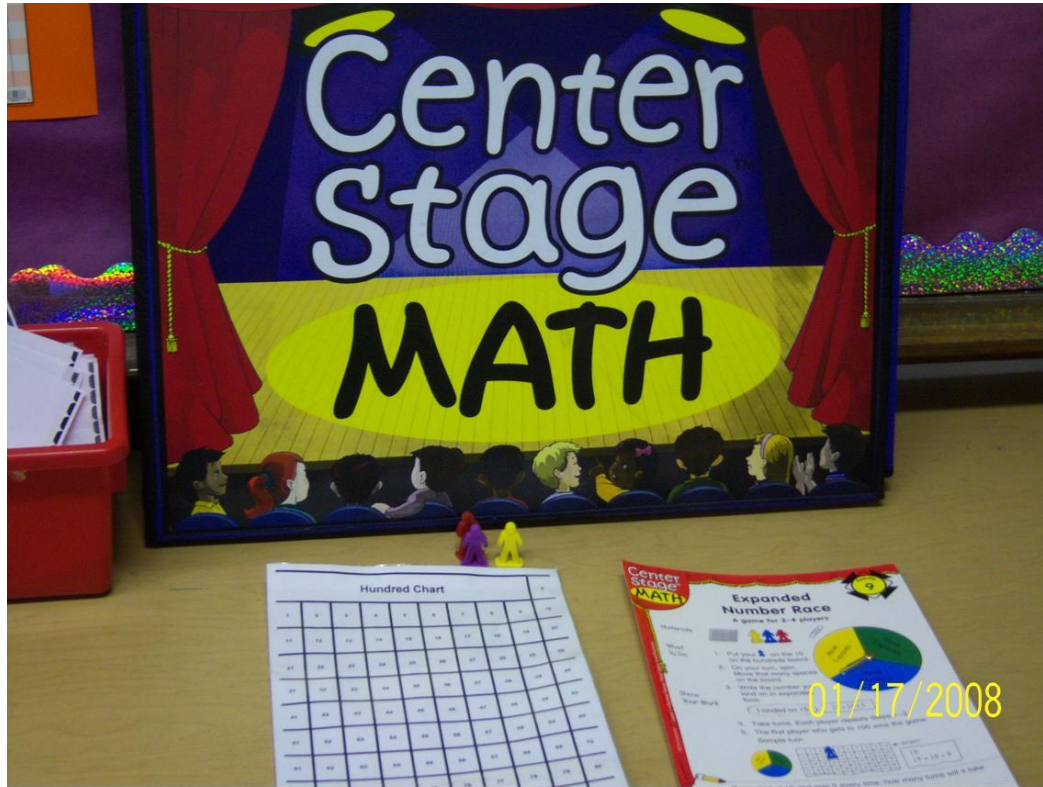
This is our science center. We are learning about life, earth, and physical science through creative play and reading.



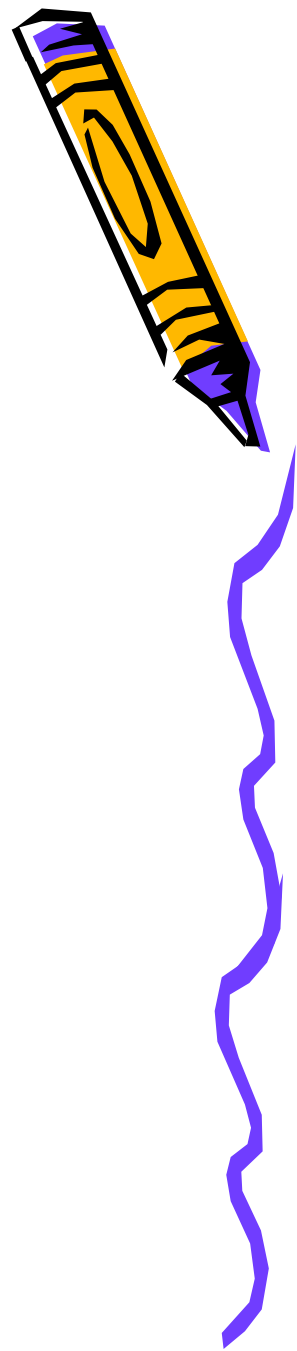


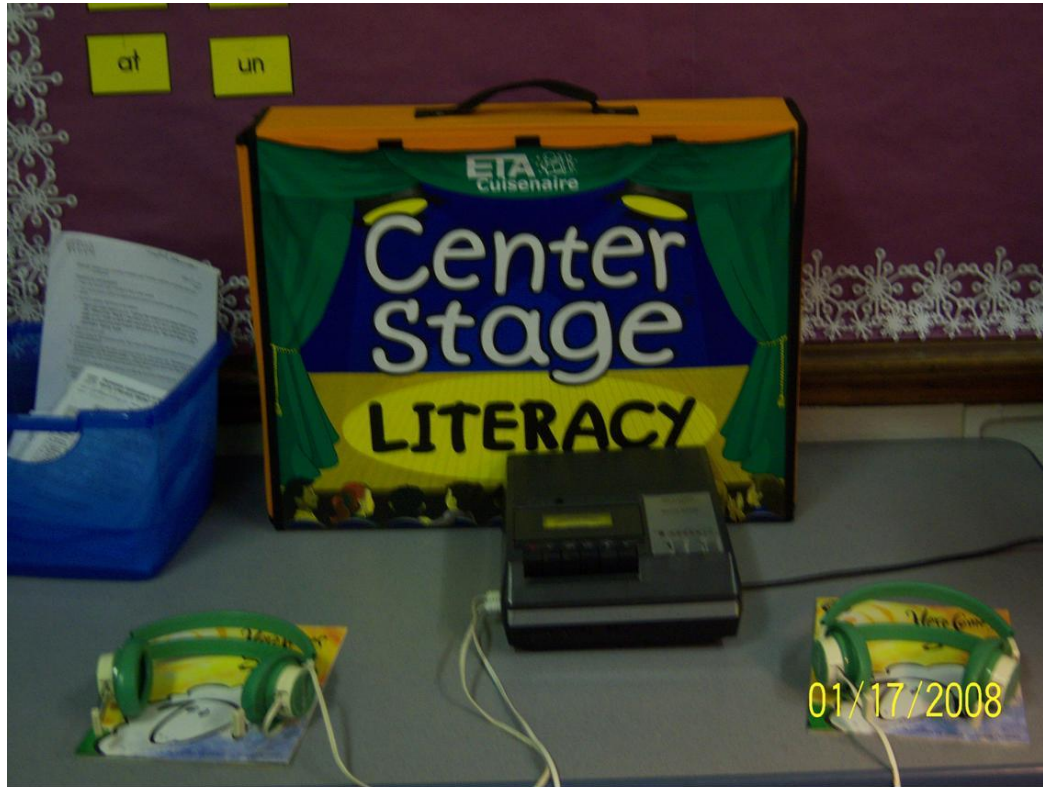
At the VersaTile center we learn about reading, math, and science through self-correcting games.



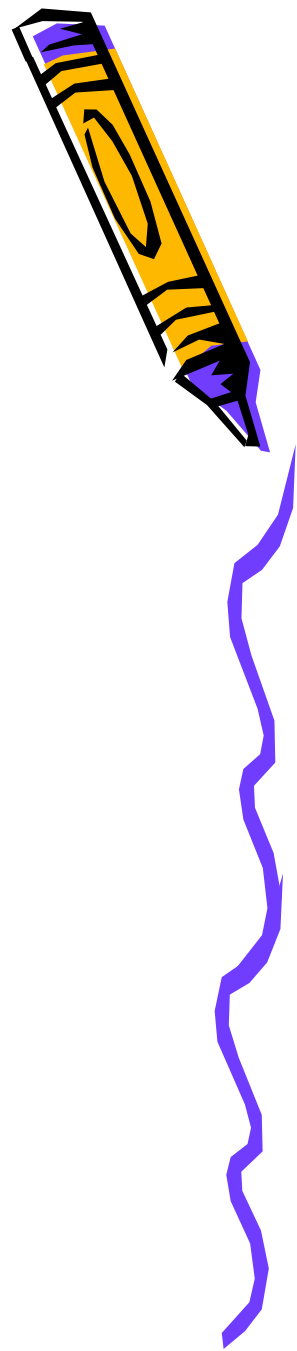


At the CenterStage Math center we learn about number sense, geometry, data and probability, algebra, and computation by using the build, sketch, and record method.



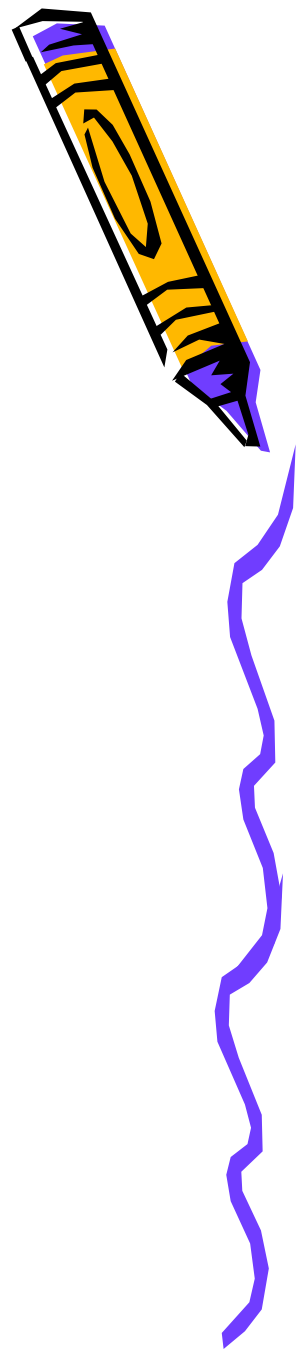


At the CenterStage Literacy we practice reading stories, telling stories, and listening to stories. In this picture we are listening to the story,  
*Here Comes the Sun.*



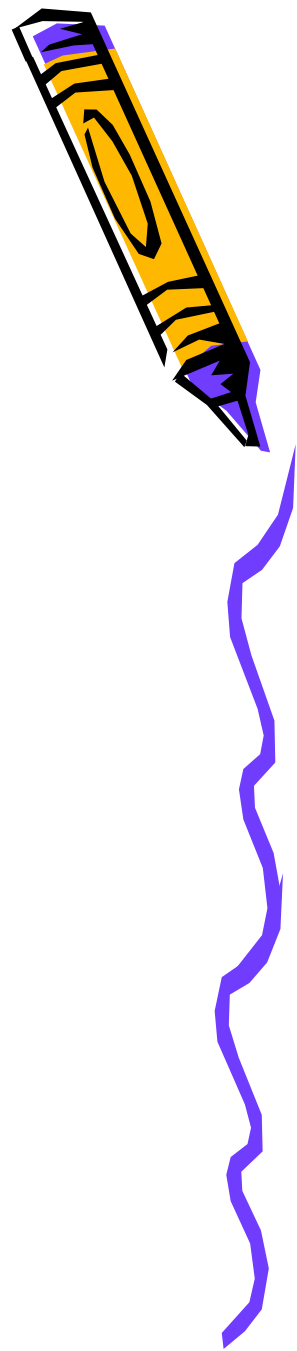

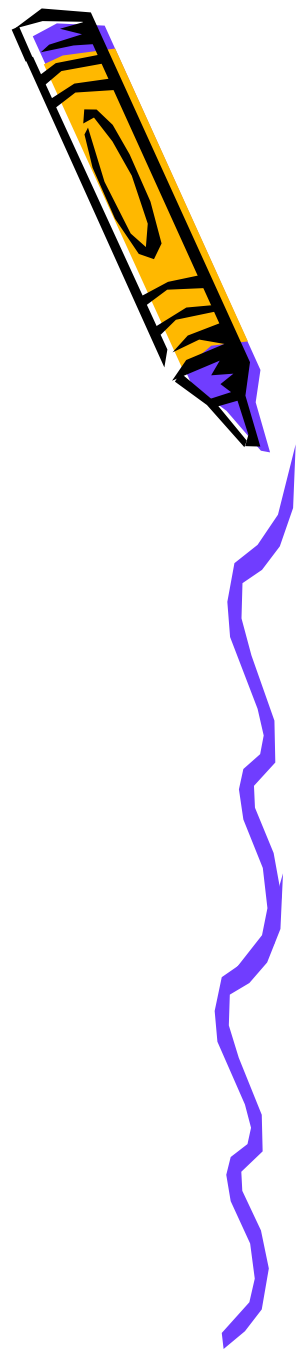


This is the teacher corner where  
Mr. Cookenmaster's desk is.



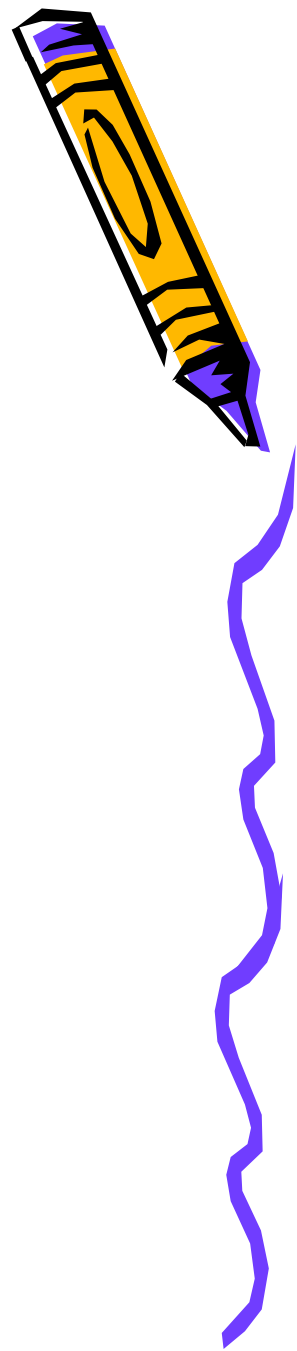
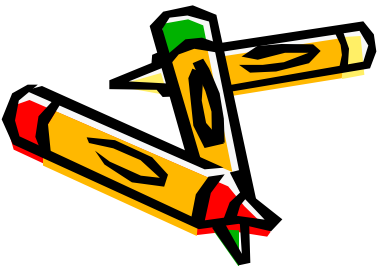


This is the front of our classroom. Frosty is welcoming us to class and says, "Happy 2008!"



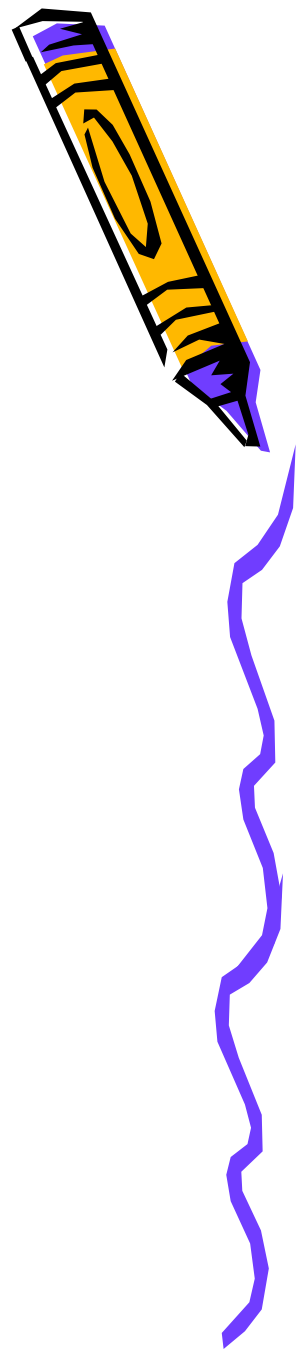


This is our creative art center. For New Years, we are making Chinese lanterns. Gung Choy Fat Cho!



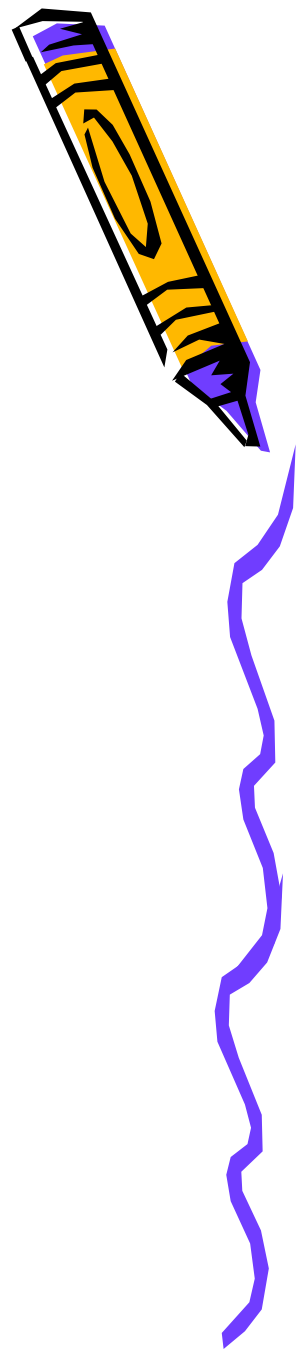


Here we build with our big foam blocks!
