

FIRE ALARM **PROCEDURE**

Should the hotel fire alarm be triggered you will be alerted by three consecutive bursts of the 'woo wah woo wah' sound.

Please follow the below guidelines in order to avoid fiery death/asphyxiation.

IN CASE OF FIRE

1. Yell 'OH MY GOD! OH MY GOD! FIRE!' Remember that people won't know that they need to panic unless you clearly alert them in this manner.
2. Collect your five most valuable possessions before fleeing accommodation. Suggested items to be saved include favourite shoes, traveller's cheques and children.
3. The building you are in is almost certainly on fire and that means gas pipes are definitely going to explode. Your safety must be your number one priority so please refrain from stopping to help elderly guests who may be less able than you to panic and run.
4. The faster you escape the lesser the risk of long term facial scarring. You can help your odds by barging other folk out of your path and shoving as hard as possible when you encounter congestion.
5. Everybody loves a hero. If you should encounter a fire then you should try and tackle it with whatever means available. If you are unable to fight the fire then at least be sure to grab a child whom you can smudge with ash and then triumphantly carry out of the building into the full view of the waiting press.
6. Only suckers use stairs so where you can, always use the lift.
7. Do not attempt to re-enter the building unless you think it is safe to do so. Fire leaping out of the windows is a danger sign, billowing smoke is probably ok.

IF YOU ARE ON FIRE

1. Panic! You're on fire for Christ sake!
2. Consult your Fire Safety Officer. Please remember to that it is impolite to interrupt.
3. If your Fire Safety Officer is too drunk to respond, dial 998 (?) and ask for the *Fire Brigade* (??)
