- Astro chart indicates good strength for long term.
- Ke period at Level II started in Dec. 04 and price moved up faster.
- Me at Level III seems also good and therefore price level may go further up during its period from 10-10-05 to 28-11-05.
- Ve at Level II appears stronger in strength than Ke. Its period would run from 28-11-05 to 29-07-08. Price would likely move up and up in few of the Level III periods during this long period of 2 yrs and 8 months. However down trend is also foreseen in few Level III periods. Detailed analysis of different Level III periods in Ve as Level II shall follow later.

It may be noted that sometimes a forthcoming good/ bad TSP can start giving results few days in advance of its commencement. This happens on account of parallax phenomenon.

<http://www.geocities.com/cosmostocks> If a TSP during a period is strong it doesn't mean that price would move up and up only. Ups and downs would take place on account of constantly moving positions of the planets. However, there is a good probability that at one or the other stage during the period, the price would move appreciably up. Likewise for the bad/ weak TSPs. This point is well explained on the above link.

How to strategize : Use of the information regarding strength of long term Level I & II and comparatively shorter term Level III TSP can be made for strategizing on investment. Suppose the long term Level I & II are assessed as good and a forthcoming Level III (short term) is also good, then buy it and then partly exit nearing a bad Level III, leaving some qty. for a future good level III TSP. However if forthcoming Level I or II is assessed as bad/ weak, then holding it becomes more risky. Over and above keep fundamentals & technicals in the fore front and use these projections for second opinion only.

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
