Minutes for July 10, 2008 meeting

The July 2008 meeting of the Country Roads Quilt Guild was called to order by President, Susan H. Several members were in attendance.

The June minutes and Treasurer's report were approved and accepted as written.

Committee Reports

Mountaineer Week Quilt show – Terry discussed the possibility of members making small items for raffling at the quilt show for profit for the guild. Terry passed around a sign up sheet for those interested.

Lending Library – Susan reviewed what items are available in the lending library.

Directory committee – Terry noted that the directories are finished. Directories were available for pick-up.

Old Business

WV Quilt Guild – The WV Quilt Guild show is at the Waterfront Hotel on July 17-19th, 2008. Terry passed around sign up sheets for those that are interested.

Block of the Month – An idea book and sign-up sheet were passed around for those interested in participating in the block of the month program to determine if there is interest.

Pat Sloan – There has been an increase in prices for Pat Sloan. The cost has increased to \$1968.00, up from \$1700.00. The date for her visit was confirmed at October 10-11th, 2008. Debbie passed out information on the different classes to choose from. Details of the workshop and lecture were discussed, including opening the workshop and lecture up to the general public in addition to the guild.

It was properly moved and accepted that for the Friday lecture, October 10th, 2008, guild members would pay \$5 to attend, while non-guild members pay \$15 to attend.

For the Saturday workshop, it was properly moved and accepted that the price for the workshop will be \$35. Guild members taking the workshop will pay the entire \$35, and will receive a \$15 refund from the guild after they take the workshop. Those not attending the workshop will forfeit the entire \$35 to the guild. It was decided by group consensus that Pat will present the Wild and Free Machine Applique class. A sign-up sheet was passed around for the workshop.

Monthly Mini – The monthly mini, made by Diane T., was won by Melissa J.

The meeting concluded with Show & Tell and a picnic at the Westover Senior Center Pavillion.
