

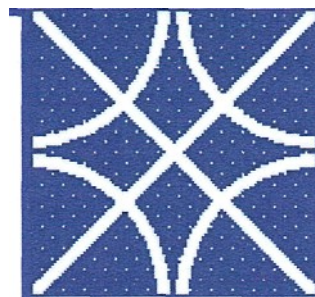

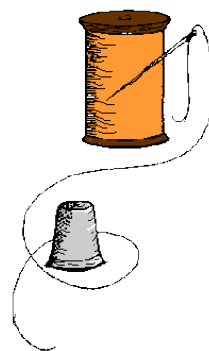
Thanks also to Betty C. for providing last month's refreshments.

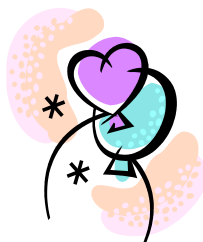
Mason Dixon Festival

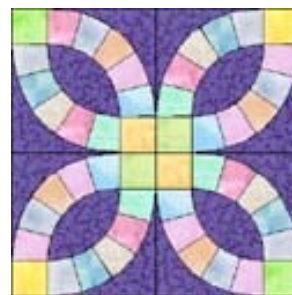

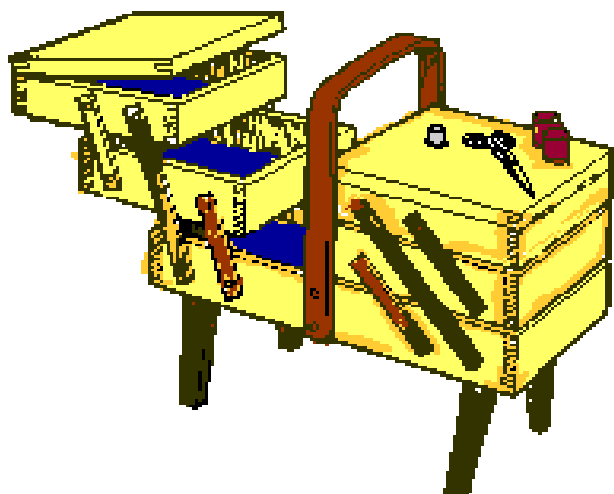
