The November meeting will be the ornament workshop. Please remember to bring a hand sewing kit. We will be making a snowman candle wrap to go around a candle jar.



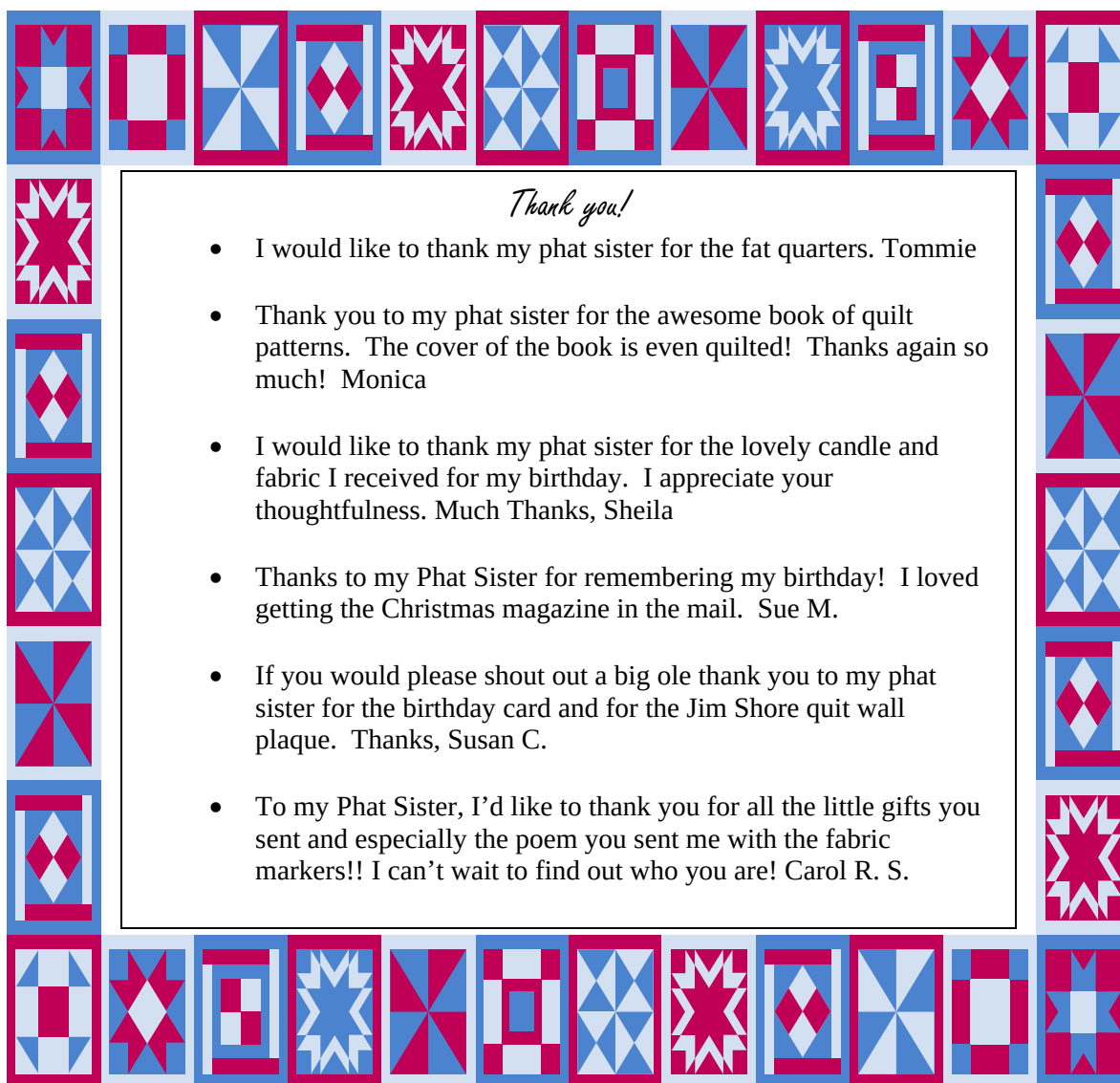
Member update from Carol:

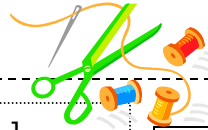
To provide an atmosphere to motivate creativity and improvement of skills.

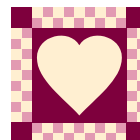

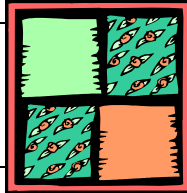

Here's a great recipe when you are in the mood for something sweet on a cold, dreary day:

Crock Pot Dump Cake

- 1 21oz. can of blueberry pie filling
- 1 box of yellow cake mix
- ½ c. of butter or margarine
- ½ c. of walnuts (optional)

Mix yellow cake mix together with butter until mixture is crumbly. Set aside. Pour blueberry pie filling into bottom of crock pot. Spoon cake mixture over it and top with walnuts. Cover and cook on low for 2-3 hours.

This is great to serve warm by itself or topped with vanilla ice cream, and the house smells wonderful while it's cooking.
