

Project HOKIE HOPE



GOAL: To make a quilt for each family that lost a loved one in the recent Virginia Tech tragedy.
To make 33 quilts, we need a total of **396 blocks**.

With the quilting community working together, I know we can accomplish this goal. You don't have to make a whole quilt to be part of this project! **YOU CAN HELP** by donating any of the following items:

- **12 ½" blocks** in any pattern using the Virginia Tech school colors of **orange** and **maroon**, plus white or cream and black or brown as accent/background colors. Sign your name and your city and state somewhere on the block.
- Cotton **batting**, in pieces at least 16" square.
- 100% cotton **fabric** in coordinating colors for backing, in pieces at least 16" square.
- Prepared **binding** in coordinating colors.
- **Thread** in neutral colors for assembling tops, coordinating colors for quilting.
- Even if you have nothing to donate, you can help to **spread the word** to your quilting friends, groups, guilds, and online networks.

There is no deadline for this project. Sooner is better so we can get started with assembly, but I don't want anybody to feel so rushed that they can't help "in time." Once I receive enough blocks, I will schedule some old-fashioned **quilting bees** for assembling the tops, basting, and quilting.
