Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of a dog being absent, disqualified, or excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the act of the Trial Committee.
NO ENTRY FEE will be returned if the show cannot be opened or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the CRDTC.
A RECORDING FEE of fifty cents (US\$0.50) will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the trial, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2)
Bitches in SEASON: A refund will be made for a bitch that comes into season after the Closing Date, provided the request is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate and is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging.
OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in the making out of entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. The owner or agent of each dog is responsible for the presence of their dog in the judging ring when their class is called. Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging. Only dogs entered in the trial are permitted at the trial site.
