WHAT IS CROSSROADS

Crossroads is the primary provider of services to homeless families and individuals in Eastern Jackson County and is open 24 hours a day/365 days per year, with a 50 bed capacity. Residents are allowed to stay for up to 60 days. In addition, Crossroads offers an outreach program to low income and near homeless individuals and families.
